Format of Photo

1. Colored images.
2. Photo(s) about International Military Tattoo publicity, events and performances.
3. Photo(s) should be in a resolution of 5.0 mega pixels or above, maximum of 6MB in JPEG format.

You are welcome to submit photo(s) via email to cp2@lcsd.gov.hk on or before 30 June 2012 (please state your name and contact number in email). Your photo(s) may be selected for displaying on the post-event activities.

Terms and Conditions

1. You will provide true, accurate, current and complete information in email.
2. Your submission of Photos may be selected for displaying on the post-event activities.
3. By submitting Photos to the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, each entrant presents and warrants that the Photos do not infringe any copyright, trademark, property rights, rights of privacy or publicity of any person, or any other right of any third party and that each entrant has the full and unrestricted right to transfer the Photos to the Leisure and Cultural Services Department free and clear of any claims or encumbrances for use in relation to the post-event activities of International Military Tattoo.
4. By submitting Photos to the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in relation to "Tattoo Snapshot", each entrant hereby grants the Leisure and Cultural Services Department the irrevocable, perpetual and worldwide license to use, reproduce, edit, display, transmit, prepare derivative works of, modify, publish, and otherwise make use of Photos in any and all media, whether now known or hereinafter created throughout the world and for any purpose, without compensation to entrant of any kind. The Leisure and Cultural Services Department further reserves, and each entrant grants the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, the right to use all submitted Photos for the Government's marketing and promotional use.
5. By submitting Photos to the "Tattoo Snapshot", you agree to grant to the Government, its authorized users, assigns and successors-in-title an exclusive, worldwide, freely transferable, sub-licensable, royalty free and irrevocable license (including sublicence as may be appropriate) ("the Licence") to copy, display, exhibit, public, adapt, modify or otherwise use the Photos and all Intellectual Property Rights herein for all purposes. The Licences shall be granted free of costs or fees with effect from the date of submitting the Photos and shall remain in effect perpetually or until the expiry of the maximum term of protection capable in law of subsisting in such licence. You shall as soon as possible upon the request of the Government do all things and execute all such further instructions or documents for purpose of conferring the said rights and interests on Government. This provision shall survive the cancellation of your submitted entries to the "Tattoo Snapshot" for whatever reasons and shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding such cancellation.
6. In this Terms and Conditions of the "Tattoo Snapshot", "Intellectual Property Rights" means patents, trade marks, service marks, trade names, design rights, copyright, domain names, database rights, rights in know-how, new inventions, designs or processes and other intellectual property rights of whatever nature and wheresoever arising, whether now known or hereafter created, and in each case whether registered or unregistered and including applications for the grant of any such rights.
7. You irrevocably waive all moral rights (whether past, present or future) in the Photos submitted to the "Tattoo Snapshot", such waiver takes effect upon submission of the Photos. Such waiver shall operate in favour of the Government, its authorized users, assigns and successors-in-title as from the submission of the Photos. This waiver shall survive the cancellation of your submitted entries to the "Tattoo Snapshot" for whatever reasons and shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding such cancellation.
8. The Government assumes no responsibility whatsoever for the contents of the Photos submitted by

you or any liabilities arising therefrom. Any disputes arising from Photos submitted by you, including but not limited to Intellectual Property Rights infringement claims, shall be resolved between the parties concerned without involvement of the Government. You undertake that you will give the Government all necessary assistance as may be required by the Government in connection with a claim which is made against the Government which arises from or relates to the Photos submitted by you, including but not limited to Intellectual Property Rights infringement claim and shall indemnify and keep the Government fully and effectively indemnified against all actions, costs, claims, demands, damage, expenses (including without limitation the fees and disbursements of lawyers, agents and expert witnesses) and any awards and costs which may be agreed to be paid in settlement of any proceedings (where that settlement has first been proposed or approved in writing by you or on your behalf) and liabilities of whatsoever nature arising out of or in connection with i) any allegation and/or claim that the use of any artistic, literary or other work arising out of the use in any manner whatsoever by the Government of the Photos submitted by you is improper or unlawful or infringes any Intellectual Property Rights of a third party and ii) any breach of the undertakings and warranties under Clause 3.
