

Importance Notice During Visit

Arrival & Departure

School buses can stop at the round-about for students to get on and off. Limited parking facilities are also available and reservations should be made at least one day before the date of visit.

Entering the Museum

The main entrance is located at the upper piazza and is reached by escalator from the lower piazza. Schools may use the Museum lobby for assembly purposes before or after the visit.

Operating the Exhibits

Operating instructions and descriptions for the exhibits are shown on panels nearby. For safety reason and to better understand the science principle behind, students should read the instructions before operating the exhibits. Teachers / Group leaders should also supervise the students when they operate the exhibits.

Demonstrations

Live demonstrations are presented during the school visit sessions. Our demonstrators will explain interesting phenomena on various science topics through experiments. Students will be encouraged to participate in some experiments.

Museum Facilities

Various facilities include first-aid room, restroom, public telephones. Restroom and escalators for the disabled are also available.

Evaluation

After the visit, teachers and students can share the experiences of what have been learnt during the visit. Besides, they can go over the questions and activities in the activity sheets. An evaluation form will be distributed to schools on the date of visit. Teachers are welcome to give valuable comments and suggestions.

Weather

The Museum will be closed on the hoisting of typhoon signal No.8 or above or the Black Rainstorm Warning. In case of bad weather or any emergency, the Museum will also be closed and all school visits will be cancelled. Schools affected may arrange another visit within the next two months. School visits may also be cancelled in accordance with any announcements by the Education Bureau. Teachers should retain admission letters for rearrangements.

Careful Use of the Exhibits

Read the instructions before operating the exhibit. The Museum may claim compensation in case of the exhibits being deliberately misused or damaged by the students.

Wearing School Uniform

For ease of identification & monitoring, students **are required to wear school uniforms** or a badge with school chops during the visit.

Safety

Do not run or play on the escalators. In case of sickness or accidents, please contact our staff for assistance immediately.

Taking Photographs

Taking photographs and video shooting for non-commercial purposes are allowed inside the exhibition halls.

Eating and Drinking

Do not eat and drink inside the exhibition halls (The snack bar on the third floor has been closed.)

Personal Belongings

Do not bring school bags, valuables or excessive amounts of money.

Students' Conduct

Do not run inside the exhibition halls. Students must be under supervision at all time during the visit.

Use of Loudspeakers

Do not use loudspeakers or amplifiers inside the exhibition halls. Teachers may use the Museum's public announcement system when necessary.
