Notes:

1. Please send the completed booking form to the Lady MacLehose Holiday Village (the Holiday Village) by post ("Astronomical Event 2012" should be marked on the envelope) or fax (fax no.: 2792 0254).
2. Each applicant or group is allowed to submit only one booking form for each programme within the specified enrolment period. Late applications will not be entertained. (The postmark date will be taken as the date of application.)
3. If the number of applications exceeds the quota, camp places will be allotted by ballot. The ballot will take place in the office of the Holiday Village at 3:00 pm on the balloting date and a waiting list will also be generated on the same day. Successful applicants will be notified in writing of payment details. If camp places are still available after the enrolment deadline for applicants on waiting list, applicants may contact the Holiday Village on 2792 6430 on or after 8:30 am on the enrolment date for unfilled camp places on a first-come-first-served basis.
4. Applicants who have not received any notification 14 days after the balloting date may consider their application unsuccessful and will not be notified individually.
5. Programme will be conducted in Cantonese.

Transportation Arrangement:

1. The Holiday Village provides free shuttle bus service commuting between Sai Kung town centre and the Holiday Village. Successful applicants will be notified of the details.

Remarks:

1. Camp fees do not include meal charges. Successful applicants will be informed of the meal arrangement in a separate letter.
2. Payment is non-refundable. The Holiday Village will not accept any transferral of quotas or camp fees.
3. If tropical cyclone warning signal no. 3 or above, or BLACK rainstorm warning signal is issued at 7:00 am on the camping day, all day camp bookings for that day will be cancelled. If tropical cyclone warning signal no. 3 or above, or BLACK rainstorm warning signal is still in force at 12:00 noon, all evening and residential camp bookings for that day will be cancelled. Campers may apply for refund of camp fees. Please retain the receipt issued by the Department for refund.
4. When RED rainstorm warning signal is issued on the camping day, please contact the camp staff for the camping arrangement before setting off for the camp.
5. With the exception of inclement weather or other circumstances leading to the closure of the camp, the paid camp fees are not refundable.
6. The Holiday Village may be used as a quarantine centre by the Government in case of an outbreak of any infectious disease. Confirmed bookings may be cancelled at short notice and campers must leave the camp as soon as possible in accordance with the Department's instruction.
