



# *Lady MacLehose Holiday Village*

## *Notes for Campers*



### **A/ Introduction**

Lady MacLehose Holiday Village locates at Sai Kung Country Park, is managed by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. It served as the quarters for the building engineers of High Island Reservoir during 70s'. After renovation, it was opened to the public as a holiday village in 1981. It accommodates 280 residential campers, 200 day campers, and 100 evening campers.

The Village has totally 56 living units. The smallest one accommodates 3 persons while the largest is 15. All units are single-storey bungalows which have self-contained sitting room, bedroom, toilet and shower facilities. All bedrooms are air-conditioned during summer months (May to October, from 1600 hrs. – 0800 hrs. next day), and there is instant hot water for showers. Bedding is also provided. Campers need only bring their clothes and cleanser.

### **B/ Transportation**

Since the Village locates at country park restricted area, unless authorized by the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department, vehicles are not permitted to enter the area.

The Village provides FREE shuttle bus services from Sai Kung Town to carry the campers to the Village at Sai Kung Tang Shiu Kin Sports Ground. The schedule is shown as follows:

For residential campers: 1330 or 1440 hrs. on the registration day and back to pick up point at 1245 hrs. on the departure day.

For day campers: 1000 hrs. on the registration day and back to pick up point at 1520 hrs.

For evening campers: 1550 hrs. on the registration day and back to pick up point at 2215 hrs.

If campers cannot reach the pick up point on time or would like to leave earlier, they can use the following transportation means:

1. Maxi cab No. 9 (Everyday from Sai Kung Town to Lady MacLehose Holiday Village, half-hourly).
2. KMB No. 94 (Everyday from Sai Kung Town to Wong Shek Pier, hourly).  
Visitors have to walk about 20 minutes after getting off the bus.
3. KMB No. 96R (Sunday & Public Holidays, from Diamond Hill MTR Station to Wong Shek Pier).  
Visitors have to walk about 20 minutes after getting off the bus.
4. Taxi.

Remarks: Applicants who wish to arrange for their own coaches (16-seater or above) to our Holiday Village should complete the "Permit to Bring Coach into Lady MacLehose Holiday Village Application Form" and then submit it to our Holiday Village by fax (Fax No.: 2792 0254) or by post for processing. For enquiries, please contact the staff of the Holiday Village at 2792 3084. The Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department has right to refuse passage of coaches if applicants fail to produce the temporary permits when coming to our Village through the Pak Tam Chung Barrier.

## C/ Catering

The Restaurant mainly provides Chinese style set meals.

Ten persons will be arranged in one dining table.

Meal Time : Breakfast 0800 hrs. (for residential campers)  
Lunch 1200 hrs. (for residential campers) 1300 hrs. (for day campers)  
Dinner 1800 hrs. (for residential campers) 1900 hrs. (for evening campers)

Meal charge : Residential camp - \$69 for each person (including dinner, breakfast and lunch)  
Day camp - \$27 for each person  
Evening camp - \$27 for each person  
BBQ - \$38 per pack

- Remarks:
1. Meals will be arranged by the restaurant of the holiday camp according to the number of campers who have paid their camp fees.
  2. Payment for meals shall be made upon check-in.
  3. Campers may reserve the BBQ food package and the pits through the restaurant in first-come-first-serve basis.

Time for BBQ: Residential Camp 1800 hrs. to 2200 hrs.  
Day Camp 1300 hrs. to 1515 hrs.  
Evening Camp 1900 hrs. to 2200 hrs.

4. If there are any changes in the number of campers requiring catering service or in the meal order, please notify the restaurant by phone and fax **at least one week** before the check-in date for confirmation and follow-up. Or, the Restaurant will charge the campers for the prepared meals.

## D/ Recreation activities

1. Activities available at the Village generally include Archery, Sport Climbing, Ropes Course, Indoor Gateball, Art and Craft, Tennis, Badminton, Squash, Table-tennis, American billiards, Mini-golf, Amusement game machines on soccer and air-hockey, Chinese billiards, Chess, Karaoke, TV Games, and Swimming (April - October) etc. Activities will be arranged in proportion to the number of campers.
2. For detailed opening hours of all activities, please refer to the programme chart in front of the Restaurant on the camping date.

\* Sports wears are required when participating ropes course, sport climbing, cycling, ball games etc.

## F/ Arrangement of adverse weather for campers

### 1. Day Camp

If typhoon signal No. 3 or above remains hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is still in force at 7:00am on the camping day, campers should not come. If the signal or warning is lowered or cancelled before 7:00am, the Holiday Camp will open as usual. Campers who do not come to check in will be regarded as waiving their rights.

### 2. Residential and Evening Camps

If typhoon signal No. 3 or above remains hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is still in force at 12:00noon on the camping day, campers should not come. If the signal or warning is lowered or cancelled before 12:00noon, the Holiday Camp will open as usual. Campers who do not come to check in will be regarded as waiving their rights.

### **3. For campers who have checked in**

If typhoon signal No. 3 or above is hoisted after campers have checked in, the campers must leave the camp. If normal operation of the Holiday Camp is affected by inclement weather, the staff will decide whether the campers should leave the Camp after taking into account the conditions at that time.

- \* If RED Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued by the Hong Kong Observatory on the day when the camp is held, applicants are advised to contact our staff by telephone before setting off for the camp (Tel. 2792 3084).

## **G/ General Rules**

1. Campers must comply with the rules of the Village. Should any person be discovered to have breached the rules, the management staff have the right to ask him/her to leave at once.
2. Activities that contravene the laws of Hong Kong or disrupt the public order such as drinking, gambling and drug taking are strictly prohibited in the Village. Those who break this rule will be asked to leave at once, and will have to bear all consequences. A report will also be made to the police if necessary.
3. No vehicles are allowed to enter the Village without authorization.
4. Visitors must complete all formalities before entering the village.
5. Please take care of your own belongings. The Village will not be responsible for any losses.
6. Campers should inform the Village for any change of the person-in-charge as early as possible.
7. Campers must not use any activity sites (i.e. archery range, ropes course, roller skating rink and sport climbing wall) when there is no instructor or camp staff attended.
8. The Manager of the Village has the right to temporarily suspend or cancel certain activities to keep in line with special arrangement.
9. The persons-in-charge should be responsible for the behaviours of their group members.
10. Campers should keep their voices down so as not to disturb the serene environment of the village. Radios and tape-recorders may be used provided that they will not cause annoyance to other people.
11. Please cherish all flowers and trees and keep the Village tidy and clean.
12. To prevent hill-fire, please refrain from smoking.
13. Our staffs have the right to reallocate bungalows if the situation requires.
14. Please keep quiet after 11pm.
15. Catering services are available in the Restaurant. No cooking is allowed in the bungalows.
16. Please keep the bungalows clean and take good care of all internal facilities.
17. No barbecue activity is allowed without the prior approval of the Village.
18. Please take your meals at the prescribed times. Late comers will not be served and board expenses will not be reimbursed.
19. Exposure of body in public places is prohibited. Swimming suits are only allowed within the swimming pool area.
20. Except with the written permission of the Village, no hanging of flags, displaying of posters, conducting of commercial activities, video recording or interview activities is allowed.
21. If campers found any wild animals, such as snakes, monkeys, boars, dogs or cows, etc., please keep calm, stay away from them, and report to our office immediately.
22. These rules are subject to amendment.

## **H/ Change of information**

Should there be any change of particular information or the arrival time, please apply in writing at least 7 working days before the camp date.
