Reply:

Of the additional provision of \$184.4 million for Programme 2 - Horticulture and Amenities in 2016-17, about \$15.8 million is for the staff costs of 37 new civil service posts including 7 time-limited posts to be created in 2016-17. Reasons for the creation and the major duties of these posts are summarised at the Annex.
