Reply:

As at March 2016, 41 leisure venues under the management of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) are provided with pet gardens. A list of existing venues, by district, provided with pet gardens is at Annex I. The LCSD plans to provide 7 more pet gardens in 2016 and 2017, details of which are at Annex II. The LCSD will continue to work with the District Councils to identify possible sites for establishing new pet gardens. Members of the public can bring their dogs to the pet gardens. Other pets which are under proper control and are effectively restrained from causing annoyance to other users are allowed for entry to parks and gardens managed by the LCSD.
