Reply:

The names and locations of the four holiday camps managed by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) are set out below:

The overall usage rates of the four holiday camps in the past three years are 77%, 74% and 76% respectively. The total staff establishment has been maintained at 74.

The renovation and maintenance works in the past three years include the improvement works for barrier-free access, replacement of air-ducts, upgrading of lifts, refurbishment works for dormitories, activity rooms and recreational facilities, minor repairs, etc. As the expenditure for these works and daily maintenance at the holiday camps is absorbed by relevant works departments, the LCSD does not have a breakdown on the expenditure involved.
