Question:

The revised estimate for 2015-16 is 2.1% lower than the original estimate for 2015-16. What are the reasons? What are the manpower and expenditures involved?

Asked by: Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki (Member Question No. 625)

Reply:

The revised estimate of Programme 3 - Heritage and Museums for 2015-16 is 2.1% lower than the original estimate. This is mainly due to the rescheduling of some museum exhibitions/programmes planned for 2015-16 to 2016-17, as well as the slightly longer than expected time for the preparatory work for the renewal of permanent exhibitions of 4 public museums. The revised estimate of Programme 3 for 2015-16 involves 711 staff with estimated personal emoluments of around \$285 million.
