Reply:

The Jockey Club "Museum of Art on Wheels" Outreach Learning Programme is a new initiative launched in October 2015. As at 29 February 2016, 25 schools had participated in this programme. The breakdown by 18 districts is at **Annex**.

The estimated expenditure is \$4.23 million (including funding from sponsorship), of which \$0.45 million is for publicity. The manpower involved in this programme is absorbed by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department's existing resources.
