## Reply:

The Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) has implemented the "Open Stage" scheme at the plaza of Sha Tin Town Hall to encourage individuals or groups to showcase their artistic talents since 2010. The Department conducted a review of the scheme in 2011 and concluded that no other suitable performing arts venues could be available for the scheme either due to lack of outdoor space, heavy usage of piazzas by hirers or noise nuisance complaints by adjacent residents.
