(2) Wifi facilities are set up to meet the operational needs of the venues such as meeting rooms or office areas having difficulties to install wired cabling. In general, desktop personal computers connected to the wired office network can support the daily office work of LCSD staff. As the existing provision of Wifi facilities is sufficient to cater

for the operational needs of the venues, LCSD has no plan to set up Wifi facilities in all office venues.
