- 2. Further to HAB210, please provide information on the planning standards and provision of open spaces and major community facilities in the planning areas of the 18 districts.

Reply:

- 1. The timetable for sports centres and sports grounds under construction or planning is set out in the Annex.
- 2. In planning new and improved sports and recreation facilities, the Government makes reference to not only the Hong Kong Planning Standards and Guidelines (HKPSG) but also other relevant considerations including the current provision of sports facilities at the territory-wide and district levels, the policy objective of sports development, utilisation rates of existing facilities, demographic changes, the advice of District Councils, site availability and technical feasibility. We shall continue to plan sports and recreation facilities to meet the needs of individual district according to the criteria as stated above.
