#### Question:

- a) What were the project details and expenditures involved in the restoration of historic buildings in the past 3 years?
- b) Further to the above, what were the project details and expenditures in connection with privately-owned monuments and public monuments in the past 3 years respectively?

Asked by: Hon CHAN Tanya (Member Question No. 137)

#### <u>Reply</u>:

- a) Under the Financial Assistance for Maintenance Scheme (FAS) administered by the Development Bureau, the private owners of graded historic buildings can apply for financial assistance for repairing and maintaining their historic buildings. Non-profit-making organisations that lease government-owned declared monuments or graded historic buildings can also apply. If an application is approved, a grant is given on a reimbursement basis. With effect from 21 November 2016, the grant ceiling was raised from \$1 million to \$2 million. Information about the restoration and maintenance projects completed in the past three years (i.e. 2015-16 to 2017-18) that were supported by FAS grants is provided at <u>Annex I</u>.
- b) Information about the restoration and maintenance projects at privately owned declared monuments that were completed in the past three years (i.e. 2015-16 to 2017-18) is provided at <u>Annex II</u>. Restoration and maintenance of government-owned declared monuments are under the purview of various government works departments or non-government bodies, which are responsible for maintaining the declared monuments in accordance with lease conditions.
