Question:

The Financial Secretary mentioned in paragraph 159 of his Budget Speech that in order to showcase Hong Kong's art and culture, the Government will progressively increase the recurrent provision to support Hong Kong's arts groups and artists to perform and stage exhibitions outside Hong Kong. It will also provide \$140 million to support local arts groups and artists for cultural exchanges in the Bay Area. Please inform this Committee of the following:

- (1) How will the provision of \$140 million be spent? Apart from the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD), what other government departments will be tasked with the co-ordination work?
- (2) What government support is currently provided in Hong Kong to local artists?
- (3) What are the details of public museums' display and commissioning of artworks by local artists, including exhibition venues, exhibition periods and attendances, in the past three years?
- (4) Regarding the acquisition of local artists' artworks by public museums, what are the types and quantities of artworks, names of artists and expenditures in the past three years?
- (5) It is indicated that \$8 million will be allocated under the Department's Capital Account to acquire and commission artworks by local artists (pages 730 and 739, Volume I). How will the provision be spent?

Reply:

(1) The Government has announced in the 2018-19 Budget that it will provide a total of \$140 million in the coming 5 years to support local arts groups and artists for cultural

exchanges in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Bay Area (Bay Area). The Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) will use these additional resources to support performances by artists and arts groups from Hong Kong or other suitable cultural exchange activities in the Bay Area with a view to showcasing Hong Kong's arts and culture while providing new opportunities to Hong Kong artists and arts groups, as well as nurturing future administrative staff and impresarios. The LCSD plans to establish a team of 6 officers to implement the aforementioned initiatives.

- (2) The Government has offered different kinds of support to local artists through the provision of art space and venues, and funding for arts groups and artists; presenting and sponsoring their productions with the provision of programme fees; acquisition and commissioning of artworks by local artists/ arts groups; and collaboration in exhibitions as well as education and extension programmes.
- (3) Details of public museum's display and commissioning of artworks by local artists are at **Annex I**.
- (4) Details of the acquisition of artworks by local artist in the past 3 years (2015-16 to 2017-18) are set out below:

(5) The LCSD has earmarked \$8 million for acquiring and commissioning local artists' artworks in 2017-18. Judging from the experience in previous years, it is envisaged that a large proportion of the funding will be spent on the acquisition of local artist's artworks. As every piece of artwork is unique by itself and the price is very much dependent on the nature, scale and artistic merits of the artwork, the spending details cannot be determined at this stage.
