## Reply:

(a) The estimated expenditure incurred by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) for acquiring artworks in 2017-18 was \$7.94 million. Details are set out below –

- (b) The provision of \$500 million will be used for acquiring artefacts and artworks which are in line with the collection policies of LCSD museums, Art Promotion Office and Hong Kong Film Archive, as well as commissioning art and cultural projects for exhibitions and public display.
- (c) The LCSD plans to use \$8 million to \$12 million for acquiring artworks in 2018-19. Similar to previous years, it is envisaged that a large proportion of the funding will be spent on the acquisition of artworks by local artists.
- (d) The LCSD has been in constant dialogue with M+ of the West Kowloon Cultural District Authority to ensure that there is no competition between LCSD museums and M+ in the acquisition of artworks.
