Reply:

- (1) & (2) The leisure venues managed by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) are primarily for sports and recreational purposes. LCSD also makes available its public pleasure grounds for non-designated uses such as cultural events, charitable activities and festive celebrations. Applications for bazaar-like activities are handled as applications for non-designated uses and considered on a case-by-case basis. The number of applications for organising bazaar-like activities processed by LCSD in the past 3 years, and the number of bazaars held are set out below.
