## Reply:

In 2018-19, the Hong Kong Wushu Union Limited received a total subvention of about \$4.3 million under the Sports Subvention Scheme (SSS). Detailed breakdown on the types of expenses is set out in the following table –

Under SSS, "national sports associations" (NSAs) are required to submit their annual plan to the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD), which will be taken into account in determining the amount of annual subvention. NSAs and LCSD will sign an annual Subvention Agreement, and NSAs must use the subvention to implement the planned programmes in strict accordance with the requirements stated in the Agreement.
