It is mentioned in the Programme that the Government will continue to implement the Five-Year Plan to enhance and increase the provision of sports and recreational facilities to meet the needs of the general public and support the development of sports in Hong Kong. - What is the progress of the respective works? Please provide a breakdown by stage of works, construction period, projected completion date, projected date of resumption of service, works expenditure.
- Are there any delays in the projects under the Five-Year Plan? If so, what are the details of such delays? What are the amounts of cost overruns involved?

Reply:

1 & 2:

The Government earmarked \$20 billion in 2017 to launch 26 projects in the following 5 years to develop new or improve existing sports and recreation facilities in different districts. Funding approval has already been obtained from the Finance Committee (FC) for 10 projects. As the projects are in progress as scheduled, information on final expenditure is not yet available. Details of the 10 projects are as follows:
