Question:

Reply:

- (1) Application and assessment of the first round of "Community-driven Projects" under the ICH Funding Scheme were completed in 2019. Information about the funded projects is set out at <u>Annex</u>. As for the first round of "Partnership Projects", applications were accepted from 8 November to 20 December 2019. Applications received are under process by the ICH office and applicants will be notified of the result in April 2020 tentatively.
- (2) Under the staff establishment of the ICH Office, 3 staff members are directly involved in supporting the ICH Funding Scheme. The expenditures incurred are absorbed by the existing resources of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.
