Reply:

- (a) To promote sports in the community, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) plans to organise about 39 000 programmes for some 2.38 million participants in 2020-21 at an estimated cost of \$205 million. These programmes include district-based activities such as sports training courses, recreational activities and competitions, as well as the School Sports Programme, Sport For All Day, events such as the Corporate Games and Hong Kong Games (HKG). To encourage wider and more regular participation in sports, the LCSD will continue to provide programmes to meet the needs of specific target groups, including programmes designated for persons with disabilities; activities suitable for participation by parents and children together such as parent-child training programmes in badminton, social dance, orienteering and ultimate; programmes targeting at young people such as track cycling, sailing, canoeing and long distance run; and less physically demanding activities such as dance, body-mind stretch, and fitness walking for the physically less active population.

Relatively less expenditure and fewer participants were/will be involved in the publicity and promotional activities in the first year (i.e. 2018 and 2020) and more expenditure and participants were/will be involved in the second year (i.e. 2019 and 2021) when the majority of the sports competitions and community participation programmes were/are held.
- (4) The Corporate Games and the Masters Games are biennial events. The Corporate Games 2020 will be held from April to November 2020 whereas the Masters Games 2020 will be held from June to December 2020.
