## Reply:

(a) The total expenditure on acquiring library materials and details on the acquisition of printed books in traditional Chinese characters, simplified Chinese characters and English, as well as non-print materials, in the past 5 years are set out at Annex I.
(b) As at 31 December 2019, the Hong Kong Public Libraries (HKPL) had a collection of 13.29 million items of print materials (books) and 1.83 million items of non-print materials (multimedia materials). The HKPL focuses on acquiring print materials in the 2 main languages of Chinese and English, where the numbers of Chinese and English books in the library collections of the HKPL were about 9.38 million and 3.91 million, accounting for $70.6 \%$ and $29.4 \%$ respectively of the total number of printed books. Acquisition of print materials in other languages will also be considered if they are bilingual, with one of the languages being Chinese or English. As the HKPL handles Chinese books as a single category without differentiation between traditional Chinese characters and simplified Chinese characters, no breakdown figures are available. The multimedia materials in the collection are not differentiated by languages and hence breakdown figures by languages are also not available.
(c) The total numbers of Chinese books, English books and non-print materials withdrawn in the past 5 years are at Annex II. As the collections of the HKPL are mainly materials in the 2 languages of Chinese and English, and that books withdrawn are only categorised as Chinese and English books without further sub-categorisation into traditional Chinese characters or simplified Chinese characters, no breakdown figures are available.
(d) The HKPL currently subscribes to about 100 titles of newspapers and periodicals published in languages of various ethnic minorities. These titles, covering information on various subjects including current affairs, language learning, sports and fitness, leisure and entertainment, etc., are available at the Hong Kong Central Library and 11 branch libraries.
(e) As at 31 December 2019, the HKPL had about 130000 physical audio books and 600 Braille books for visually impaired persons. In addition, the public can access about 216000 e-books including 11700 audio e-books in the 11 e-book collections acquired or subscribed to by the HKPL through the Internet workstations in static libraries that are equipped with Cantonese and English voice synthesiser software. We will continue to identify more physical audio books and suitable audio e-books in the market to meet public needs.
