### Reply:

The resources allocated by the Government to support the development of elite sports and the promotion of sport for all and sports development among people with disabilities in the past 5 years are set out below. The amount of funding to be allocated in 2020-21 has yet to be finalised.

#### **Note**

The substantial increase is mainly due to the enhanced support provided to athletes with disabilities under the Pilot Scheme for Elite Vote Support Scheme for disability sports since December 2017, and the provision of funding support to the Hong Kong Sports Association of the Deaf for staging the 9th Asia Pacific Deaf Games in Hong Kong in November 2019.
