Question:

Regarding e-books, please provide this Committee with the following information for each of the past 3 years: (1) the number and growth rate of books; (2) the usage rate and number of users as well as the respective growth rates; (3) actions to be taken by the Department to step up promotion and increase the usage rates; and (4) a breakdown of the actual expenditures and the amounts involved, as well as the estimated expenditures for 2020-21.

Asked by: Hon KWOK Ka-ki (LegCo internal reference no.: 105)

Reply:

- (1) As at 31 December 2019, the Hong Kong Public Libraries (HKPL) had acquired or subscribed to 11 e-book collections with about 338 000 items. The total number of titles and growth rate of e-book collections in the past 3 years are at <u>Annex I</u>.
- (2) Unlike physical library materials, e-book collections are hosted by service providers and licensed for library use at service providers' platforms through an annual subscription or a perpetual licence. Different service providers use different statistical elements, such as the number of e-books consulted, searches, tracks played, browses by category, to present the usage of their databases. The usage and growth rate of e-book collections in the past 3 years are at <u>Annex II</u>.

Regarding the number of users, registered borrowers of the HKPL can enjoy one-stop access to all e-book collections through the HKPL website. The number and growth rate of registered borrowers of the HKPL in the past 3 years are tabulated below:

- (3) The HKPL is committed to the promotion of e-book collections to various sectors of the community by regularly organising educational and extension activities, library visits by schools/organisations, briefing sessions on electronic resources, "School Culture Day", and through customer liaison groups, teacher liaison groups as well as paying visits to schools/community groups/organisations. The HKPL has also launched Online Registration for Borrowers and Take a Break eReading Corner to facilitate readers' access to e-book collections anytime and anywhere. In addition, the HKPL participated in the Hong Kong Book Fair and the Learning and Teaching Expo to promote its e-resources to members of the public and teachers. The HKPL will produce demonstration videos with a view to stepping up publicity on the internet and social media in encouraging members of the public to access e-books.
- (4) The expenditures and estimates on the acquisition and subscription of e-book collections from 2017-18 to 2020-21 are provided at <u>Annex III</u>.
