Reply:

In 2019, the Hong Kong Public Libraries (HKPL) accepted about 24 200 items of donated books and declined the donation of about 2 300 items. School textbooks, titles already in stock, books that are outdated or in poor physical condition, etc. are normally not accepted unless they are of high reference and research value. A breakdown of declined donations by reasons is not available. Subject to the indicated wish of donors, items that are not accepted will be returned to donors or at the disposal of the HKPL.
