**Reply:**

1. In 2013-14, over 160 artworks, including paintings, prints, ceramics, mixed media, multi-media, installation and photographic items, have been acquired by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) under Subhead 677 "Acquiring and commissioning artworks by local artists". These artworks belonged to 35 local artists whose names are set out in the Annex. The total estimated expenditure on the acquisitions is \$4.28 million. As some of these artists offered their artworks at discounted prices and requested the museums not to disclose the price information, the LCSD is not in a position to disclose the expenditure on the individual artworks.

The LCSD has earmarked \$9.05 million for acquiring and commissioning artworks under this Subhead in 2014 -15. As each piece of artwork is unique and the price varies depending on its nature, scale and artistic merit, the number of artworks to be acquired/commissioned and the number of artists involved cannot be estimated at this stage.
