**Sport Education Programme — Sport Exhibition**

- Objective:** To enhance students' knowledge of and interest in sports
- Target Group:** Students of secondary, primary and special schools
- Content:** To organise a series of exhibitions in which display panels will be used to present in a light-hearted manner the information on sports, the relationship between sports and health, sport injuries, the influence of sports on the growth of the youngsters and the Badges Award Scheme etc.
- Quota:** No restriction
- Venue Requirement:** School halls, covered playgrounds or indoor facilities
- Fee:** Free
- Topics Covered by Display Panels:**
- (A) Set A, with 10 pieces of display panels (1m X 2m), covers four topics, namely benefits of sports, sports and nutrition, sports and health, and sports and injury.
  - (B) Set B, with 8 pieces of display panels (1m X 2m), covers two topics, namely sports and stress management, and sports and multiple intelligence development.
  - (C) Set C, with 7 pieces of display panels (1m X 2m), covers the core techniques of the ball games under the Badges Award Scheme.
  - (D) Set D, with 9 pieces of display panels (1m X 2m), covers the core techniques of sports other than ball games under the Badges Award Scheme.
  - (E) Set E, with 8 pieces of display panels (1m X 2m), covers two topics, namely sports and weight management, and sports and self-efficacy.
  - (F) 6 pieces of display panels (1m X 2m) to introduce the sportACT Award Scheme.
- Note:** All schools participating in the Sport Exhibition for (A) to (E) will be given a set of posters on their selected topic after the exhibition as a souvenir from the LCSD.
- Enrolment Method:** Schools should send the duly completed Sport Exhibition Enrolment Form to the School Sports Programme Unit by fax (Fax No.: 2684 9076) or by post (Address: 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin) three months before the proposed date of the activity.
