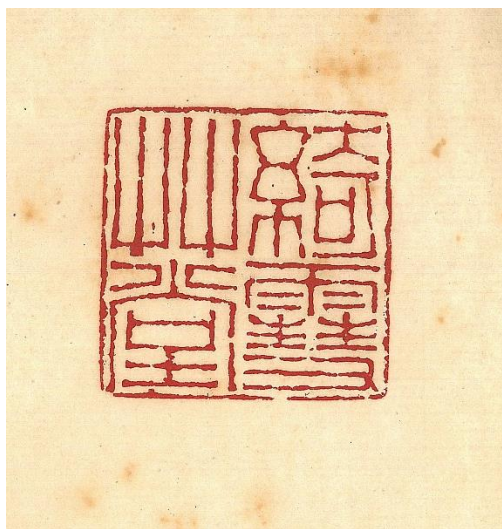
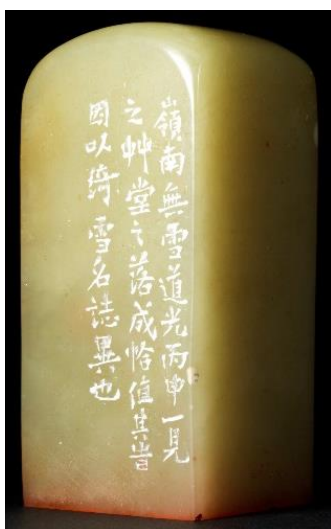


黄裔 (约 1883–约 1932)

黄裔，广东南海（今佛山）人。约 1883–约 1932。字慕韩。书斋名号为劬学斋、绮霞++堂。早岁曾习西医，惟未曾成为执业医生。黄氏家藏典籍、书画、拓本甚丰。好诗，曾遍游日本及国内名山大川，皆有吟咏。嗜隶书。治印不宗一家，而以雅劲为尚。广结收藏界、美术界、文化界人士，与黄咏雱交情甚笃，1929 年曾为黄咏雱《芋园北江游草》诗集题诗祝贺。

HUANG Yi (c. 1883–c. 1932)

Huang Yi (c. 1883–c. 1932), a native of Nanhai (present-day Foshan), Guangdong, courtesy name Muhan, was born into a family that had a rich collection of books, calligraphies, paintings and rubbings. He named his studio Quxue zhai and Qixia caotang. Although he studied medicine in his early years, he did not pursue a career as a doctor. He was a poet, calligrapher and seal carver who had travelled to Japan and many parts of China. He was sociable and enjoyed good connection with legions of collectors, artists and cultural elites. A close friend of Huang Yongyu's, he wrote a poem for him to offer his congratulations on his publication of the poem collection *Yuyuan Beijiang youcao* in 1929.
