谢云生，广东南海（今广州）人。1760-？，约活动于清乾隆、嘉庆年间。谢景卿长子，谢兰生兄长。擅书法、篆刻。治印受浙派影响。勤于研究印学，曾为父亲整理摹录《续集汉印分韵》。

XIE Yunsheng (1760-?)

Xie Yunsheng (1760-?) active between the Qianlong and Jiaqing reigns), a native of Nanhai (present-day Foshan), Guangdong, was the son of the notable connoisseur Xie Jingqing and the elder brother of the scholar-artist Xie Lansheng. He was a calligrapher and seal carver influenced by the Zhe School of seal carving. Steeped in the seal carving, he helped his father with the compilation of the sequel to *Hanyin fenyun*.
