叶期,广东南海(今佛山)人。?-1914。字退庵、退庵、退厂,以字行。工八分书。刻印专 攻浙派,冷峭隽永,所作朱文逼肖黄易,白文厚朴而挺劲。叶氏亦工于魏晋人书法,边款亦孤 逸疏宕,独树一帜。昔日广州双门底的登云阁,就是退庵悬润例鬻印处。

YE Qi (?-1914)

Ye Qi (?–1914), a native of Nanhai (present-day Foshan), Guangdong, was more widely known by his courtesy name Tui'an. Accomplished in the clerical script, he carved seals focusing on the style of the Zhe School. His relief seals are reminiscent of Huang Yi, and his intaglio seals emit weightiness, simplicity and robustness. His side inscriptions are considered unique for their vibrancy and untrammeled quality. Ye also excelled in the calligraphy of the Wei-Jin period. He had sold seals at the bookstore Dengyun ge in Shuangmendi, Guangzhou.
