

Notes on Placing Meal Orders in Advance

Welcome to the Restaurant at Lady MacLehose Holiday Village. To ensure provision of satisfactory meal services, we advise you to take note of the following information:

1. Campers are required to place an advance order for basic meals (i.e. basic Chinese/Western style breakfast; and lunch and dinner, each consisting of five designated courses and one soup) or other catering services (including special set meals, cooked dishes, meal boxes, barbecue packs/barbecue food and other food items) with the restaurant by email, post or via WhatsApp on #8482 9097) **at least one week before the check-in date**. Please call the restaurant for confirmation and follow-up if a reply is not received within 2 days.
2. We provide either standard meals (i.e. basic Chinese style breakfast; five designated courses with one designated soup for lunch and dinner) or other meal services including special set meals, cooked dishes, meal boxes and barbecue packs. Meal arrangements will be made according to the number of campers stated in the advance order. Diners will be seated in 10 per table. Parties of less than 10 may have to share tables with others. For instance, three parties of three each will be arranged to sit together around a table.
3. Advance orders for standard meals, barbecue packs and meal boxes must be placed with a **minimum order quantity of three**, with adults and children being charged at the same rate. The number of diners seated must correspond to the number of meals placed in the advance order. For instance, a minimum of 10 meals/barbecue packs/meal boxes must be placed for a party of 10. In case the actual number of diners exceeds the number of diners for which advance orders have been placed, a fee payable for such additional diners must be paid on a per head basis. Despite this, no additional or separate meals will be arranged for them. Fees are not payable for children aged under 3 if no seats or meals are required.
4. Each barbecue pit can accommodate 10 people and are only available to those campers who have ordered barbecue packs/barbecue food from the restaurant in advance. Since the barbecue pits are limited in number, they are only available to campers on a first-come-first-served basis upon their placement of orders. **For orders containing fewer than four barbecue packs, campers may be required to share a barbecue pit with others.**
5. Meal hours (**40 minutes each session**) and standard meal fees

(Note: Campers are required to return tables after meal hours to facilitate cleansing or arrangements for the next meal hours by the restaurant. Thank you for your understanding.)

6. When an order is placed, the restaurant will confirm the amount of meal fees and provide its account details. Name of the account **Holiday Eatery** and respective account code is **012-688-2-024287-4**. If no confirmation is received, the order in question should be deemed invalid, for which campers must contact the staff of the restaurant.
7. Campers must pay the meal fees to the person-in-charge of the restaurant direct by means of transfer via automatic teller machines, payment via cash deposit machines, transfer via FPS or bank accounts, or crossed cheques (for schools and groups only) five days before arrival. Upon payment, please send a screenshot or a photo of the receipt to the staff of the restaurant via WhatsApp on 8482 9097 for confirmation.
8. Only set meals of the day, meal boxes or noodles will be available for those campers who have not placed meal orders in advance. Their meal hours must also be subject to the camp type (i.e. day/residential/evening) (please refer to the table above). The final decision regarding their meal hours rests with the restaurant.
9. For seating arrangements, please enquire with the counter staff of the restaurant before meal service.
10. Campers must arrive punctually for meals. Meal fees must be settled in full, and no make-up meals or separate arrangements will be available for late arrivals or those unable to attend due to absence or other reasons. All paid meal fees will not be refunded.
11. A Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal 3 or above is in effect. If the camper reserves a 3-day, 2-night camping period and is unable to enter the camp, the relevant fees will be refunded. After the Observatory has canceled the warning signal, the camp has been reopened. Campers should enter the camp to enjoy the remaining reserved meals. The reserved meal fee is not refundable if the camper cancels the trip.
12. Meal fees may be adjusted in accordance with changes in the Consumer Price Index (A). Enquiries may be made to the staff of the LMHV Office or the restaurant.
