Secondary School Section Open to all students who are studying in day time secondary 1 to 6

Submission Methods

By Email

- Participants shall submit the completed enrolment form together with the slogan to avs@lcsd.gov.hk.
- Please indicate "Water Safety Slogan Competition" and the category of participation in the subject line of the email.

By Post

- Please indicate "Water Safety Slogan Competition" and the category of participation on the mail.

Specifications of Entries

- The slogan must be related to the theme and written in Chinese in no more than 14 words, punctuation is not included.
- The slogan must be written on the enrolment form (form should be printed in A4 size paper or submitted in PDF format).
- The slogan should be concise, harmonious, creative, easy to remember and suitable for publication.

Adjudication

The adjudicating panel comprises representatives from the HKLSS, the LCSD as well as the Education Bureau.

Awards & Prizes

Ten winners of each section will be presented a certificate and prize money will be awarded in the following manner: -

Highly Commended Awards of HK\$100 each will be granted to seven subsequent runners-ups. All prize money is sponsored by the HKLSS.

Result Announcement

Results will be published in May 2022. Winners will be informed individually by email and phone. All winning entries will be uploaded to the website of the LCSD for public viewing.

Terms and Conditions

- Entries must be the original work of the entrants and must not infringe the rights and interests, including copyright, of any other parties. Winning entries of other competitions will not be accepted.

- Each participant may submit one individual entry only. Participants who submit multiple entries, only the last submission would be accepted, and the rest would be disqualified without further notice.
- Participants should complete the enrolment form and write down the slogan on the form. If the enrolment form is incomplete or the information is incorrect, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify the application without explanation or notification.
- Entries should not contain any material that is political, obscene, violent, pornographic, defamatory, indecent, disparaging or content that is controversial and inappropriate.
- The content of the slogan must conform to the theme of this competition. All entries must be original, have neither been openly shown or publicised in any other platforms, nor have been submitted for other competitions.
- All submitted entries will not be returned and will be owned by the Organiser.
- All winning and/or shortlisted entries will be uploaded to the website of the LCSD for public viewing.
- The Organiser has the right to publish the name, the category of participation and the name of school of the entrants.
- The Organiser or associated parties shall not be liable for any loss, delay, or postage error of the submission.
- The Organiser reserves the right to interpret and change the terms and conditions, and reserves the right of the final decision.
- Decision of the adjudicating panel and the Organiser is final. No objection and appeal will be entertained.
- The Organiser has the right to request the winners to provide identification proof for verification. Prizes will only be awarded upon verification of identity.
- Participants shall fully understand the terms and conditions of the competition. Upon submission of enrolment form, participants shall be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the terms and conditions set out in this prospectus.
- All staff of the Organiser, contractor, members of the judging panel and their immediate family members are not allowed to participate in this competition.

Copyright
