1.	Objectives	:	To promote school greening campaigns, raise the awareness of students about greening and cultivate their interests in growing plants.	
2.	Theme	:	One Person, One Flower Scheme:

3.	Details of the Scheme	:	The LCSD will provide videos to participating schools via email in October and early November 2022, explaining the precautions the schools should take when receiving flower/herb seedlings and demonstrating how to plant theme flowers respectively.	
			A ballot will be conducted according to the district where the school is located to determine the order of flower/herb seedlings delivery. The result will then be uploaded onto the LCSD's webpage for inspection by participating schools in October 2022. The flower/herb seedlings will be delivered in phases by the LCSD's contractors in the order of priority determined by balloting between early November and mid of December 2022.	
			One Person, One Flower Scheme:	
			- The school will receive the theme flower seedlings for free according to the proposed number of participating students. <u>Each participating student will be given one seedling</u> .	
			- The seedlings are delivered as a group in seed trays, each of which containing 50 seedlings. The school will arrange distribution of the seedlings to students for planting either at homes or in schools.  The school should prepare its own planting media and pots.	
			Planting Herbs in School Scheme:	
			- The school will receive a total of 15 herb seedlings for free, with 5 seedlings for each type of herb.	
			- The herbs should be planted <u>in schools</u> only.	
			- The school may organise planting activities for their students in the campus, e.g. planting herbs in the flower bed at school.	
4.	Date of Completion	:	All activities of the schemes must be completed on or before 31 March 2023.	

5.	Compilation of Activity Record Book and Completion of Questionnaire		Upon completion of the schemes, participating schools are required to compile an Activity Record Book in A4-size containing photographs with descriptions to illustrate the planting of flower/herb seedlings and the related activities, and complete a questionnaire provided by the LCSD. Both the record book and questionnaire should be submitted to the LCSD on or before 31 March 2023 (Students are not required to hand in planting reports/homework.).
