Hong Kong Flower Show 2022 Points to note for participants to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Participants shall comply with the following requirements and any other requirements as may from time to time be updated and advised by the Organiser, Centre of Health Protection (CHP) and/or the Food and Health Bureau of the Government during the Show Period:

- 1. All visitors shall wear masks at all times on entry and inside the venue.
- 2. All visitors shall be subject to body temperature checks before entry. Those with symptoms (e.g. fever, acute respiratory discomfort, sudden loss of taste or smell) will be prohibited from entering the venue. Those who have symptoms but are already inside the venue shall leave immediately and should seek early medical advice.
- 3. Those inside the venue should maintain social distancing as specified by the LCSD. The number of persons admitted to the venue shall not exceed the prevailing limit on group gatherings as stipulated by the Government for epidemic prevention purposes.
- 4. There shall be no stalls selling food and drinks inside the venue. No one is allowed to eat or drink inside the venue.
- 5. The "LeaveHomeSafe" venue QR codes will be displayed at the entrance of the venue. All visitors shall scan the venue QR codes with their phones' "LeaveHomeSafe" mobile apps on entry. Persons who are aged below 15 or aged 65 or above, and those with disabilities that render use of the app difficult, will be exempted from the requirement of using the app when they enter the venue. However, exempted persons are required to complete a record form to register their names, the first four digits or letters of their identification documents, their contact numbers and the date and time of their visits.
- 6. Participants will need to have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

Only under two circumstances can the vaccination requirement be exempted: individuals are (1) ineligible for vaccination due to age; or (2) unfit for vaccination due to health reasons with relevant proof from a medical practitioner.

- 7. To step up anti-epidemic efforts, visitors may consider wearing eye protection equipment such as goggles and face shields, while changing masks in a timely manner when they got soiled. All visitors are also required to observe hand hygiene and refrain from any activities which may generate aerosols, such as shouting, chanting or singing songs.
- 8. All visitors shall comply with the latest directions of the Government issued by notice published in the Gazette or otherwise under all applicable Ordinances and subsidiary legislation thereunder (including but not limited to the Prevention and Control of Disease Ordinance (Cap. 599) and all subsidiary legislation thereunder including the Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation (Cap. 599F), the Prevention and Control of Disease (Prohibition on Group Gathering) Regulation (Cap. 599G), the Prevention and Control of Disease (Wearing of Mask) Regulation (Cap. 599I)) and the Prevention and Control of Disease (Compulsory Testing for Certain Persons) Regulation (Cap. 599J), as well as any directions given by the LCSD on the prevention and control measures against infectious diseases such as COVID-19 to be implemented at the venue. Those contravening or failing to comply with the above regulations, requirements or directions may be liable to prosecution.
- 9. In view of the latest development of COVID-19, the LCSD may revise the above anti-epidemic measures. In addition, the LCSD may adjust the scale and opening hours of the HKFS, tighten the admission requirements for members of the public, or even cancel the whole event.
