Scales: in the above keys (minors in both melodic and harmonic forms)

Scale in thirds: F major

Chromatic Scales: starting on any note E–A (two octaves)

Arpeggios: the common chords of the above keys for the ranges indicated

Whole tone Scales: Starting on G and Ab (two octaves)

Dominant Sevenths (resolving on tonic): In the keys of E and G (a twelfth)

In the keys of C and Db (two octaves)

Diminished Sevenths: starting on G# and G (two octaves)

B, C, Db, D, Eb majors; B, C, C#, D, Eb minors (a twelfth)

F# major; F harmonic minor (extended range scale)

All other keys, major and minor (two octaves)

Scales: in the above keys (minors in both melodic and harmonic forms)

Scales in thirds: G and Ab majors (two octaves)

Chromatic Scales: starting on any note E–Bb (two octaves)

Whole-Tone Scales: starting on A and Bb (two octaves)

Arpeggios: the common chords of the above keys for the ranges indicated

Dominant Sevenths: In the keys of Ab (a twelfth)

In the keys of A, D and Eb (two octaves)

Diminished Sevenths: starting on E, A and Bb (two octaves)

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
