

# <u>Instrumental Music Training Scheme of Music Office</u> Recruitment for 2021/22 Intermediate Year One & Advanced Year One Courses

The Instrumental Music Training Scheme (IMTS) of the Music Office, which offers a comprehensive course of music training, inclusive of musicianship and music theory, has a current enrolment of more than 4,500 trainees from beginners to advanced level. The scheme comprises 3 independent courses of training: a 2-year Elementary Course, a 3-year Intermediate Course & a 3-year Advanced Course. Weekly one-hour group lessons are conducted in Cantonese at a designated music centre, with other arrangements like online teaching made under special circumstances. Trainees will be issued a certificate upon completion of each course. Annual tuition fees: Elementary Year-1 - \$1,764, Elementary Year-2 - \$2,156, Intermediate Year-1 to 3 - \$3,377 and Advanced Year-1 to 3 - \$4,312, are payable in 4 instalments.

Trainees with financial difficulties can apply for fee remission, but would need to continue their payment of tuition fees until their applications have been approved. All applications must be accompanied by relevant document proofs such as valid certificates issued by the Student Finance Office or the Social Welfare Department for assessment of subsidy level. Deadline for applications: 31 December 2021.

The Music Office is now recruiting Intermediate Year-1 and Advanced Year-1 trainees for 2021/22. Young people of suitable musical standards are welcome to apply. (**Note**: Recruitment for Elementary Year-1 courses will take place in July)

#### I. Entry Requirement

- Intermediate Year-1 (I-1) A 3-year intermediate course equivalent to the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) Grade 3-5 in standard. Applicants must have attained an ABRSM Grade 2 or equivalent standard.
  - Note: (1) This training programme is not suitable for trainees who have attained an ABRSM Grade 3 or above or equivalent standard.
    - (2) Current Music Office E-2 trainees who wish to receive intermediate training <u>must also submit an application</u> though <u>no proof</u> of musical attainment would be required.
    - (3) With the exception of E-2 trainees, applications from current Music Office IMTS trainees will not be considered under normal circumstances.
- Advanced Year-1 (A-1) A 3-year advanced course equivalent to ABRSM Grade 6-8 in standard. Applicants must have attained an ABRSM Grade 5 or equivalent standard.
  - Note: (1) This training programme is not suitable for trainees who have attained an ABRSM Grade 6 or above or equivalent standard.
    - (2) Current Music Office I-3 trainees who wish to receive advanced training <u>must also submit an application</u> though <u>no proof of musical attainment would be required.</u>
    - (3) With the exception of I-3 trainees, applications from current Music Office IMTS trainees will not be considered under normal circumstances.

#### **II. Application Procedure:**

- 1. By post / in person: The completed application form, together with proof of musical attainment like copies of exam results or instructor's recommendation or testimonial and 3 self-addressed envelopes★ stamped with sufficient postage, should be sent by mail or submitted in person to the music centre, where the applicant's first choice class will be held on or before 16 May 2021. [Please note that (i) applications without proof of musical attainment will not be considered; (ii) applications submitted by post must include an envelope with a clearly-written return mailing address; (iii) applications postmarked after the application deadline will not be considered; (iv) faxed, emailed or late applications will not be accepted]. Applicants who have not received any acknowledgement of receipt of application by 21 May 2021 should contact the music centre where their first choice class will be held.
  - ★ As applicants who have provided their email addresses on the application form will be contacted by email thereafter, they would not have to enclose any self-addressed envelopes in their applications.
- 2. Online application: Applications, together with proof of musical attainment should be submitted through the Music Office online application system (<a href="www.lcsd.gov.hk/musicoffice">www.lcsd.gov.hk/musicoffice</a>) on or before <a href="16">16</a> May 2021</a>. Applicants will receive an acknowledgement of receipt with an application number upon completion of the online application. The same acknowledgment of receipt will also be emailed to the applicant thereafter (Please check all mailboxes, including inbox, junk and spam mail to avoid misdeliveries). Applicants who have not received the acknowledgment receipt should consider their application unsuccessful and submit a new application. In case of doubt, they can call the music centre where their first-choice class will be held on the next working day.
- 3. Each applicant is allowed only ONE application (whether in person, by post or online) at either the intermediate or advanced level, or else he/she will be disqualified. Successful applicants can only enrol in one instrumental class.
- 4. Successful applicants should not be enrolled in similar instrumental courses at tertiary institutions, including Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts junior programme, at the same time, otherwise, he/she will be disqualified.

#### **III. Audition Arrangement:**

- With due consideration to the epidemic, applicants are to submit a recorded video performance for assessment.
- Qualified applicants who have not received any notifications on submission of the video performance by 2 June should check the Music Office website for audition arrangements or contact the music centre of their first choice.
- Deadline for video submission is 20 June 2021. Late submissions will not be considered.

# V. Class Commencement:

- 2021/22 Intermediate and Advanced classes will commence in September 2021. Successful applicants will be notified of the confirmed class schedule, venue and registration arrangements in early August. Applicants can check their application results through the Music Office website from 5/8/2021 onwards. (Note: no class transfer is allowed during the first year of study).
- With the exception of a few bulky instruments (harp, double bass, tuba, bulky percussion instruments), all trainees must be equipped with their own instruments for practice and class use.[Note: Yangqin and zheng will be provided for class use]
