## (II) Camp Rules

1. Campers must follow the camp rules and instructions and arrive at the Music Office music centre 15 minutes before each training session. Open rehearsals are not available.
2. Campers are required to wear the camp name tags during rehearsals and at the Camp Concert venue for identification purposes. Open rehearsal/ dress rehearsal of camp concerts is not available.
3. Campers are required to arrange their own lunch, and may have their packed lunch in a designated location of the Music Office music centre. No eating or drinking is allowed in the rehearsal rooms.
4. The Chief Music Officer reserves the right to update the camp rules and make the final decision on any dispute.

## (III) Camp Concert Rehearsal and Performance Arrangement

Campers must arrive at the performance venue 30 minutes before the start of the following rehearsal time and report to the training group manager.

### B. 6/8 (Sun) or 14/8 (Mon):

If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 is issued on the day of the Music Camp Concert, i.e. 6/8 (Sun) or 14/8 (Mon), but the Hong Kong Observatory has not indicated that Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above is expected in the afternoon, campers should rehearse and perform on that day, and report to the training group manager at the Hong Kong City Hall Concert Hall at the time specified in Part (III). If the Red or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued on 6/8 (Sun) or 14/8 (Mon), the Chief Music Officer will exercise discretion to decide whether rehearsal/ performance will continue, taking into consideration campers' safety. Parents/ guardians will be notified through Short Message Service (SMS) as soon as possible.

## (V) Leave Application Procedures

1. Campers must attend all training sessions and rehearsals. Any leaves must be approved by the Music Office in advance.

2. Leave application procedures are as follows:

#### Campers aged under 18

- i. A duly completed application form <sup>(6)</sup> stating the reason, date and time of leave must be countersigned by the parent/ guardian. Application form without parent/guardian signature is not accepted.
- ii. The duly completed application form for leave must be submitted to the training group manager for processing and approval from the Chief Music Office/ Senior Music Officer/ Music Officer.

#### Campers aged 18 or above

- i. Campers shall notify their parents in advance, and submit a duly completed application form stating the reason, date and time of leave to the training group manager for processing and approval from the Chief Music Office/ Senior Music Officer/ Music Officer.
3. For campers aged under 18, who are granted approval for leave, their parents/ guardians shall be responsible for their children's off-site safety as well as transportation arrangements.
4. The Leisure and Cultural Services Department shall not be liable for the safety of campers off-site.

5. Campers who have a record of leave on more than two occasions or have been absent from training/rehearsals for more than seven hours will not be eligible for the Music Camp attendance certificates.
  6. Any fees paid will not be refunded, even if the campers are approved for leave.

## **(VI) Precautionary Measures to Prevent Communicable Epidemic Diseases**

1. Campers should bring along face masks (suggested at least 2 pieces per day) and disinfectant alcohol towels or alcohol spray/ gel.
2. Campers with symptoms of respiratory infection should wear masks.
3. If campers experience physical discomfort, including fever, diarrhea, vomiting, red eyes, rash, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, loss of taste or smell, or other symptoms of upper respiratory tract infection, they should not attend the training and seek medical advice as soon as possible.
4. Campers with fevers (above 99.5°F or 37.5°C) must stop their training. They are only allowed to resume training after full recovery certified by a doctor.
5. According to the “Guidelines on Prevention of Communicable Diseases” issued by the Centre for Health Protection of the Department of Health, if campers suffer from COVID-19, influenza or respiratory tract infections within a short period, the Music Office has to report to the Department of Health and take measures to prevent the spread of diseases. Campers are required to comply with the directive of the Music Office to stop the training and leave the training venue. Any fees paid will not be refunded.
6. Upon necessity, the Music Office may impose other precautionary measures to which all campers must adhere.

## **(VII) Others**

1. The Music Office reserves the right to change the programme and training arrangements.
2. The Music Office shall have the absolute discretion to use any photographs, videos, or any other record of the music camp training and concert for any lawful purposes including but not limited to archiving, advertising, and promotion.
