

Music Office Recruitment for 2025/26 Band/Choir/Orchestra Members

The 18 Music Office bands/orchestras and two choirs, trained by Music Office instructors, provide different levels of ensemble training for young musicians aged 25 or under. Rehearsals are conducted once a week, with details on rehearsal time & venue are listed in the following pages.

In addition to regular rehearsals, the 20 bands/choirs/orchestras will also have opportunities to perform and participate in various cultural activities and music exchanges with visiting young musicians from the Mainland and overseas. Outstanding members may be recommended for enrolment in the Music Office Instrumental Music Training Scheme. Training for 2025-26 will be held from September 2025 to May 2026.

Entry Requirements and Fees

Entry requirements for the respective bands/choirs/orchestras are detailed in the following pages. Training is free of charge, but members are required to bring their own instruments (except for bulky instruments) and purchase uniforms and necessary music scores at their own expense.

Application Method

- Online application:** Applications should be submitted through the Music Office online application system :- (<https://www.lcsd.gov.hk/en/mo/training/bandchoirandorchestratraining.html>) on or before **6 May 2025**. Applicants will receive an acknowledgement of receipt together with an application number upon completion of the online application. The same acknowledgement of receipt will also be emailed to the applicant thereafter (Please check all mailboxes, including inbox, junk and spam mail to avoid misdeliveries). **Applicants who have not received the acknowledgement receipt should consider their application unsuccessful and submit a new application.**
- By post / in person:** The completed application form, together with (i) supporting proofs of musical attainment that showing applicants have attained the required standard of the applied band/choir/orchestra, and (ii) 2 self-addressed envelopes* with sufficient postage, should be sent by post or submitted in person **to the training centre of the selected band/choir/orchestra [1]** on or before **6 May 2025, with name of band/choir/orchestra clearly marked on the envelope.**
* As applicants who have provided an email address on the application form will receive all notifications by email, there is no need for them to enclose any self-addressed envelopes in their applications.
- Except for choir applicants, applicants of band and orchestra **must** submit one of the following supporting proofs showing that they have attained the required standard (**Applications without supporting proofs will not be considered**):
 - copies of other music examination board results; or
 - instructor's testimonial; (Remark: For the convenience of applicants in need, they can download an instructor's testimonial template from the Music Office recruitment website or collect it at music centres for reference or use. Besides, if applicants submit copies of music contest results or certificates, they are also required to submit an instructor's testimonial at the same time.)
- Qualified applicants will receive an audition notification on or before 31 May 2025. The audition will include a performance of a selected repertoire meeting the required standard for the applied band/choir/orchestra, and/or stipulated excerpts/ scales and arpeggios, and sight-reading or sight-singing. (The audition venue listed in the notification may be different from the training centre where the applicant's selected band/choir/orchestra rehearses.)
- Current members must also re-apply.**
- Applicants will be notified of their application results on or before 15 August 2025.
- Each applicant should submit only 1 application, otherwise, he/she will be disqualified.
