Participants should wear proper sportswear and sports shoes.</li> <li>3. Priority will be given to schools which have participated in the cricket training under the Easy Sport Programme between September 2019 and December 2020 to take part in the “Easy Sport Competition – Cricket Competition” under the School Sports Programme in 2021. Details will be announced later.</li> <li>4. Upon completion of a training course under the Easy Sport Programme or Outreach Coaching Programme, participants will have acquired skills of a certain level. If the NSA has arranged a coach for a school and the school requests before the activity date the cancellation of the activity, NSA will deduct from the fee for each activity an administrative fee (\$190 per Sport Demonstration; \$380 per training course under the Easy Sport Programme or Outreach Coaching Programme) and refund the balance to the school.</li> <li>6. If the request to cancel a Sport Demonstration is made by the school on the day of the activity, no re-scheduling or make-up session will be arranged. All fees paid will not be refunded.</li> <li>7.
