Purpose: To help students learn and understand cricket.

Type of Badges: 1. Three levels of award, namely Bronze, Silver and Gold
2. Content of Tests

Levels of Award	Assessment Items
Bronze	Fielding, Batting, Bowling and Knowledge
Silver	Fielding, Batting, Bowling and Knowledge
Gold	Fielding, Basic Batting, Elective (Advanced Batting, Wicket Keeping and Bowling) choose one out of three, Knowledge

3. Rating Standard

Trainees must pass the tests of all items in accordance with the skill requirements of the respective levels to obtain relevant badges.

Award/ Participation Method: All trainees participating in cricket training courses of the Easy Sport Programme, the Outreach Coaching Programme and the Joint Schools Sports Training Programme under the School Sports Programme will be assessed by coaches at the end of the courses based on the contents of the respective tests. Trainees who meet the standards will be awarded a certificate by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) free-of-charge.

Collection of Badges and Certificates: After completion of the assessment, the coaches will submit trainees' results to the LCSD for verification of information, upon which the LCSD will mail the certificates of the badges to the schools for distribution to qualified trainees by teachers.

Badge Test	Bronze (For anyone, suggested for primary students)
Fielding	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Demonstrate “Attacking Fielding” 2. Demonstrate “Long Barrier” 3. Demonstrate catching using “Cup Method” 4. Demonstrate catching using “Reverse Cup Method” 5. Demonstrate “Over Arm Throw”
Batting	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Show batting “Stance” and “Grip” 2. Demonstrate “Front Foot Drive” 3. Demonstrate “Pull Shot” 4. Demonstrate “Sweep Shot”
Bowling	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Demonstrate “Bowling” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - with correct foot position, and - with straight arm
Knowledge	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 25 multiple choices questions, need to get at least 15 marks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 mark for each correct answer - 0 mark for each blank answer - (-1) mark for each wrong answer

Fielding	<p>The Coach or Assessor will feed the balls underarm</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ground Fielding: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Stop 4/6 balls properly, and - Throw 2/4 to the target area 2. Catching: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Catch 4/6 balls, and - Throw 2/4 to the target area
Batting	<p>The Coach or Assessor will feed the balls underarm accordingly</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Drive: (one or two bounces feed) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hit 4/6 balls, and - Get runs for 2/4 balls (one or boundary) 2. Pull Shot/ Cut Shot: (no bounce, chest height) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hit 4/6 balls, and - Get runs for 2/4 balls (one or boundary) 3. Sweep Shot: (rolling on floor) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hit 4/6 balls, and - Get runs for 2/4 balls (one or boundary)
Bowling	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bowl 6 legal balls in 10 deliveries
Knowledge	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 25 fill-in-the-blank questions, need to get at least 18 correct answers

Badge Test	Gold (For Silver Badge holder, suggested for senior secondary students)
Fielding	The Coach or Assessor will feed the balls underarm 1. Stop or Catch 10/12 balls, and 2. Throw 8/10 to the target area
Basic Batting	The Coach or Assessor will feed the balls overarm with one bounce Need a runner of candidate's choice 1. Get 4 runs/ 12 balls with proper calling
Elective (Candidate to choose one out of three)	Advanced Batting: (The Coach or Assessor will feed the balls overarm with one bounce. Need a runner of candidate's choice) 1. Get 10 runs/ 12 balls with proper calling - with proper turning at crease - with only 1 or 2 runs
Knowledge	1. Please use less than 1000 words to introduce cricket to a person who has no cricket background (20 marks) - have to answer in essay form, answer in point form will not be marked - marks will not be deducted for grammatical and spelling mistakes - include history(2), spirit of cricket(1), ground & equipment(5), format & rules(3), batting(4), bowling & fielding(4), how to win(1)
