The Futsal Promotion Scheme
Prospectus

- 1. Purpose**
1. To promote futsal in campuses and improve the youth's football skills by means of continuous training; and
 2. To enhance teachers' understanding in futsal through theoretical and practical sessions, teaching them how to organise futsal activities / training courses, set up school teams and hold competitions in schools, with a view to introducing futsal into campuses for wider participation by the youth.
- 2. Quota**
- A quota of 28 in total, with primary and secondary schools as target participants. In case of oversubscription, the list of successful applicant schools will be determined by ballot.
- 3. Venue**
- School playgrounds/basketball courts or 5-a-side hard surfaced soccer pitches
- 4. Course Details**
- I. Outreach Coach Training Course (School Team)(6 courses)**
- The Hong Kong Football Association (HKFA) will send registered coaches to schools to conduct continuous training programmes in a systematic manner, in a bid to enhance students' football skills, particularly with a focus on the application of team tactics during competitions.
 - The programme comprises 6 training courses in total, each of 12 hours and with an enrolment quota of 16. Schools may have the programme to be held between the start of the school term and summer vacation.
- II. Futsal Organiser Training Course (1 course)**
- The HKFA will send experienced coaches or instructors to introduce the basic knowledge of being futsal referees and coaches and their practical application.
 - Participating schools must recommend a teaching staff member to attend the course.
 - The course, divided into three modules, will last for 3 days with dual emphasis on theoretical and practical sessions, covering both the basic and advanced knowledge / techniques of futsal. Practical opportunities, in particular those related to application of tactics, GAG (Global-Analytic-Global) training methods and practices in game modes, will be offered to participants to experience the fun of futsal.
- III. Futsal Promotion Scheme – Futsal Competition**
- Those schools having participated in “Outreach Coach Football Training Course” or “Futsal Promotion Scheme” from September 2017 to

December 2022 may enrol in the “Futsal Promotion Scheme – Futsal Competition”.

- The Competition is divided into 3 stages, namely the 1st Semester, the 2nd Semester and the Finals, all anticipated to be held from December 2022 to June 2023. Details will be announced in due course.

IV. Futsal Themed Exhibitions

- The LCSD has produced futsal themed exhibition panels for display in campuses by those successful applicant schools under the Scheme. For each of these schools such panels may be displayed once a school year for no more than 14 days. The LCSD will arrange free delivery and installation.

- 5. Fee** \$8,800 per school (inclusive of those for organising 6 Outreach Coaching Training Courses and 1 Futsal Organiser Training Course)
- 6. Enrolment Period** From now until 5 August 2022 (Friday) (determined by the postmark date)
- 7. Enrolment Method** Please send the completed application form, together with a cheque in payment (made payable to "The Hong Kong Football Association Limited" with school names written clearly on the back), to the School Sports Programme Unit of the LCSD by post to 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin.
- 8. Ballot** In case of oversubscription, a ballot will be conducted in the lobby on 1/F of the Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters at 3:00 p.m. on 15 August 2022 (Monday). As the arrangements of such a ballot may be affected by anti-epidemic measures, those schools wishing to send representatives to attend should contact Mr CHAN on 2601 7606 by 11 August 2022 (Thursday) for further arrangements.
- Schools allocated with a quota will be notified in writing on or before 18 August 2022 (Thursday). No notifications will be separately issued to unsuccessful applicant schools.
