1. Objective: To offer a competition opportunity for students who have joined the "Outreach Coaching

Programme" and "Joint School Training Programme" for Rhythmic Gymnastics organised by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) to pit their skills against each

other and improve physical fitness.

- 6. Eligibility:
- a. Participants must be students of whole-day or half-day primary schools for the 2024/25 academic year.
- b. Enrolments should be made on a school basis (with school chop on the enrolment form) and participants must be current students of their schools at the time of the competition.
- c. The following gymnasts will not be accepted in Junior A, Junior B & Junior C divisions:
  - 1) Gymnasts who placed **top 8** in any individual event of the following competitions:
    - 2021/2022 Hong Kong Rhythmic Gymnastics Open Championship (5/12/2021)
    - 2023 Hong Kong Rhythmic Gymnastics Age Group Competition (15-16 & 29-30/4/2023)
    - 2023-2024 Hong Kong Rhythmic Gymnastics Open Championship (4-5 & 18-19/11/2023)
    - 2024 Hong Kong Rhythmic Gymnastics Age Group Competition (13-14 & 27-28/4/2024)
    - 2024-2025 Hong Kong Rhythmic Gymnastics Open Championship (30/11, 1/12/2024 & 18-19/1/2025)
    - 2025 Hong Kong Rhythmic Gymnastics Age Group Competition (5-6, 12-13 & 26-27/4/2025)

  Enrolment:
- a. If oversubscribed, places will be allocated by ballot.
- b. In such case, the ballot will be held at the office of the School Sports Programme Unit on 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters at 3:00pm on 10 June 2025 (Tue). School representatives are welcome to attend.
- c. Successful schools will be notified via fax by the LCSD; unsuccessful schools will not be contacted further.
- d. Applicants should submit the completed enrolment form, together with a crossed cheque payable to "The Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China Limited" with the school name written on the back <u>within the enrolment period</u> through the following channels:

For enrolments by post, the date of postmark will be taken as the enrolment date; for enrolments by email, the date of receipt of the enrolment form by the LCSD will be taken as the enrolment date. **Enrolments by fax or late enrolments will not be accepted.**

- g. Once admitted, the enrolment fees paid will not be refunded, except in cases of oversubscription or event cancellation.

(ii) Participates who complete any routine will be awarded a "Certificate of Attendance".

#### b. Individual all-around

Participants must participate in all events of their respective divisions. In each division, the top 8 gymnasts with the highest combined scores from all events will receive the following awards:

#### c. Active participation

The school with the highest number of participants will be awarded the certificate of "Award for Active Participation".

# 12. Scoring criteria:

#### Individual events

a. Junior A, Junior B and Junior C

Routines contained in the "Rhythmic Gymnastics New Routine Workshop" will be the designated routines for ball, hoop and ribbon events. **Details of the scoring criteria for elements in the routines are available at the website of GAHK** (http://www.gahk.org.hk).

Talent Group A, Talent Group B and Talent Group C

Current course routines of the Joint Schools Sports Training Programme are the designated routines for the events.

Enquiries about details of the scoring criteria for elements in the routines can be directed to GAHK.

- b. Starting score is 10 points. Deductions of 0.1 to 0.5 points will be made for each error depending on its severity.
- c. 0.1 points will be deducted for each small error in execution, 0.2 points for each medium error, and 0.3 points for each large error.
- d. 0.1 points will be deducted for each additional movement, empty movement in place of technical element, wrong direction or trajectory.
- e. 0.1 to 0.5 points will be deducted per routine for absence of harmony between music and movement, unfamiliarity with apparatus elements and insufficient amplitude in elements.
- f. All other scoring will follow the FIG (Federation Internationale de Gymnastique) 2025-2028 Code of Points.

# 13. Points to note for the Competition:

- a. All music for the Competition will be provided by the Organiser.
- b. Participants must bring their own apparatus for the events:
  - (i) Ball 15 to 20cm in diameter and at least 300g in weight
  - (ii) Hoop 60 to 90cm in diameter (a discrepancy of inner diameter not exceeding 1cm is allowed)
  - (iii) Clubs 35 to 50cm in length and at least 90g in weight each
  - (iv) Ribbon 4m to 5m or above in length and at least 30g in weight
- c. The performance order for all participants will be determined by ballot at the team managers' meeting. No objections will be entertained.
- d. <u>Registration:</u> Participants must report to the "Registration Desk" at their scheduled reporting time with a valid photo-bearing identification document (e.g. Hong Kong Identity Card, student card or student handbook) for verification. Those who fail to produce identification or whose registration details contain discrepancies will be disqualified.
- e. <u>Roll Calls:</u> The Roll Call Area is restricted to participants scheduled for check-in and their coaches/school teachers/team managers (who must wear an official "Team Manager Pass"). Once roll call begins, gymnasts must remain in the area until their event concludes, unless otherwise authorised.
  - Gymnasts must pay close attention to all announcements. They must report to the Roll Call Area immediately after the first call. The event will commence right after roll call concludes with the final call. Three unanswered calls will result in forfeiture of the right to compete and will be considered a voluntary withdrawal from the competition. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any gymnasts who are found to be unenrolled to the Competition.
- f. Access to the competition area is restricted to competing gymnasts and individuals wearing a "Team Manager Pass" or "Guardian Entry Pass". Spectators may watch the event from the stands. Each participant may request up to three "Guardian Entry Passes", which grant access only to the warm-up area. "Team Manager Passes" and "Guardian Entry Passes" must be collected at the Registration Desk prior to the start of the competitions.
  - Coaches or school teachers/team managers who need to assist participants in the competition area must submit the "Team Manager Pass Electronic Application Form" online by 28 June, 2025 (Application URL: <a href="https://forms.gle/rQjjiA6tB9uYRe8KA">https://forms.gle/rQjjiA6tB9uYRe8KA</a>) to apply for the "Team Manager Pass".

# Holders of "Team Manager Passes" must be aged 16 or above. Late submissions will not be accepted.

- g. For participants who fail to complete any event, the Organiser reserves the right to revoke their eligibility for prizes.
- h. The competition schedule shall be as announced on-site.
- i. Procedure for score inquiries:
  - An inquiry for scores must be filed in writing or verbally at the command post. Inquiry forms are available at the post;
  - An inquiry must be submitted within 4 minutes after the score is displayed. The inquirer will then be informed of the gymnast's DA and DB scores, and will be given one minute for consideration. Any inquiry confirmed after the one-minute time limit will not be accepted. A cost of HK\$1,000 per inquiry shall be paid once the inquiry is confirmed;
  - Only the following parts are subject to an inquiry:
    - Difficulty of Body (DB); or Difficulty of Apparatus (DA) (The cost for inquiries concerning both DB and DA is HK\$2,000.)
  - Any inquiry submitted beyond four minutes after the score is displayed will not be accepted;
  - Upon receipt of an inquiry, the Superior Jury will review the competition footage and re-evaluate the scores;
  - A final score will be announced after deliberation to confirm whether the inquiry has been upheld;
  - If the inquiry is unsuccessful, the final score may remain unchanged or be reduced. The fee paid will not be refunded and no further appeal will be accepted;
  - The fee will be refunded if the inquiry is upheld.
  - No inquiries into E score and A score will be accepted. Coaches may instead enquire about the calculation and input of scores at the command post.
- 14. Inclement Weather Arrangements:
- a. If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, or a Red/Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force two hours before the reporting time for the first round of events on the competition day; or the Environmental Protection Department announces an Air Quality Health Index (AQHI) of 10+ ("Serious" health risk category) recorded at its general monitoring station in the concerned area; or the Education Bureau announces class suspension, all events on that day will be cancelled. Participants will be notified of alternative arrangements in due course. Participants are still required to report to the venue on time under heavy rain. The judges will determine whether competitions proceed as scheduled.
- b. All ongoing competitions <u>will be suspended immediately</u> if the AQHI recorded at the general monitoring station in the area reaches 10+ ("Serious" health risk category).
- 15. Notes:
- a. The information provided will only be used by the Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China and the LCSD for matters relating to enrolment in recreation and sports programmes, future contact, compilation of statistics and opinion survey. Only staff duly authorised by the LCSD and the Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China will have access to the personal data. For correction of or access to the personal data after submission, please contact the School Sports Programme Unit of the LCSD at 2601 7608.

#### 16. Remarks:

- a. Gymnastics involves certain risks. To offer protection for participants, the Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China requires all participants to take out a personal accident insurance. Participants may also procure additional insurance according to their own needs.
- b. Photocopying of the enrolment form is permitted.
- c. Details of the competition (such as competition schedule, gymnast no. and performance order) will be uploaded to the website of the Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China after the team managers' meeting.
- d. The Organiser reserves the right to verify gymnast information with coaches/gymnasts. Teams or gymnasts providing false information will lead to immediate disqualification with all medals and results nullified. The enrolment fee will not be refunded.
- e. Photographing or filming at the competition venue requires application via email to the Organiser two weeks prior to the event. Photographers must register at the command post and wear the "Photo Pass" on the competition day. The Organiser reserves the right to prohibit any unauthorised person from photographing or filming at the venue. The "Photo Pass" is valid for this competition only. Photographing and filming should only take place in the permitted area.
- f. Any enrolment submitted with incomplete information will not be considered without further notice.
- g. The enrolment fee will not be refunded.
- h. In case of any inadequacy or updates to this prospectus, the Organiser reserves the right of final interpretation.
- i. The Organiser holds ultimate authority over all competition matters.
