- Purpose** : To provide a 20-session advanced squash training course of 40 hours for potential players.
- Entry Requirement** :
1. Applicants must be *aged 15 or below*;
  2. Priority will be given to students who have participated in the Outreach Coaching Programme – Squash under the School Sports Programme and remain in the same school by the time of enrolment for this training programme;
  3. Highest priority will be given to those who are aged 11 or over and have received the Bronze Award under the HK Junior Squash Award Scheme.

- Inclement Weather Arrangement** :
- The programme will be cancelled in the event of school suspension announced by the Education Bureau or the following severe weather conditions:
    - The Hong Kong Observatory issues the Red / Black Rainstorm Signal, Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above two hours before the activity, or
    - If the Environmental Protection Department announces that the Air Quality Health Index recorded by general stations reaches the “serious” level (i.e. 10+), outdoor activities in the affected areas must be stopped immediately; or
    - If the Education Bureau announces class suspensions or in the event of other emergencies, the activity on that day will be canceled, and further arrangements will be notified separately.
    - The date of the lesson may change subject to the availability of venues and the weather conditions. Please contact the coach-in-charge in advance for enquires on the lesson arrangement.
