2026 Easy Sports Competition – Park Orienteering
 [Prospectus]

1. Objective: To offer former participants of the Easy Sport Programme — Orienteering under the School Sports Programme an opportunity for exchanges to further develop their interests in orienteering, enhance their skills and gain competition experience.
2. Eligibility:
 - a. Former participants of the Joint Schools Training Programme — Park Orienteering/ Easy Sport Programme. Participants must compete in the division corresponding to his/her age.
 - b. The Elite Class (Division F) is open only to former or current participants of the Ranking League.
3. Date, Time and Venue:

5. Notes to Applicants:

- a. Please submit the online application form at (<https://jotform.com/form/253638638582470>) on or before 25 February 2026. A list of successful applicants will be posted on the website (<https://oahk.org.hk>) of the Orienteering Association of Hong Kong, China (OAHK) on 9 March 2026. For enquiries, please contact the OAHK staff.
- b. Once payment has been made, no substitution of participants will be permitted. Any requests for cancellation or refund will not be accepted.
- c. Participants must be bona fide students of the school they represent for the duration of the Competition.
- d. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis until full capacity is reached. Late applications will not be accepted.

6. Fee: HK\$25 per person

7. Application and Payment Period:

4 - 27 February 2026 (Except Family Orienteering Experience event)

8. Format:

- a. Divisions A, B, C, D and E: Individual score event
- b. Division F: Individual cross country event
- c. Family Orienteering Experience event: Participants must team up a parent to participate.
- d. Unless otherwise specified in this prospectus, all other rules shall follow the current competition regulations employed by the OAHK.
- e. The Organiser reserves the right to make any changes to the format as deemed necessary.

9. Reporting:

- a. Participants shall report to the Organiser 15 minutes before the scheduled time of the Competition. Any participants failing to appear within five minutes after being called shall forfeit the Competition.
- b. Participants must present a valid photo-bearing identity document (e.g. student handbook, student card, student registration card issued by the Schools Sports Federation of Hong Kong, China) before the Competition for verification of eligibility.
- c. The competition schedule is subject to the announcements on-site.

10. Inclement Weather Arrangements:

- a. The Competition will be cancelled if any of the following circumstances arises within two hours before the Competition starts. The OAHK will arrange for refund in due course.
 - i. Amber/Red/Black Rainstorm Signal, or Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 or above is in force; or
 - ii. The Environmental Protection Department has announced that the Air Quality Health Index (AQHI) recorded at its general monitoring stations in the competition area reaches 10+ ("Serious" health risk category).
- b. If The Hong Kong Observatory has issued a thunderstorm warning on the competition day, participants should still report to the meeting point as scheduled and pay attention to the Organiser's announcement.

- c. During the Competition, if the AQHI recorded at the general monitoring stations in the competition area reaches the following levels, the following measures shall apply:
- i. AQHI at 7 (“High” health risk category): Participants with heart, respiratory or chronic illnesses should minimise outdoor physical exertion and outdoor exposure, especially in areas with heavy traffic, and should take breaks more frequently;
 - ii. AQHI at 8 to 10 (“Very High” health risk category): Participants should avoid outdoor physical exertion and outdoor exposure, especially in areas with heavy traffic;
 - iii. AQHI at 10+ (“Serious” health risk category): All ongoing competitions shall be **suspended immediately**.

11. Remarks:

- a. Participants are advised to wear light-coloured and loose-fitting sportswear and sports shoes. It is also recommended to bring water, a watch, a towel, a hat, sunscreen, mosquito repellent and rain gear.
- b. Participants should check for Competition details, which will be uploaded to Eventor World (<https://hongkong.eventorworld.org/Events>Show/769>) after 23 March 2026.
- c. The information provided by the applicants will only be used for purposes of application in this Competition and related promotional purposes.
- d. The OAHK has taken out public liability insurance. Participants and their parents may consider taking out other insurance policies at their own discretion and expense.
- e. The OAHK reserves the right to amend the competition prospectus at any time without further notice. Should there be any disputes, the OAHK’s decision shall be final.
- f. The Organiser reserves the right to take photographs, videos or audio recordings, or conduct live broadcasts during the event, and to use such recorded materials on the Internet, at Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) venues, on the Organiser’s dedicated website, in publications, and through other publicity channels for promotional or record-keeping purposes.

12. Awards:

The Award Presentation Ceremony will be held on the competition day.

- a. For divisions A, B, C, D, E and F, a champion, a 1st runner-up and a 2nd runner-up will be awarded in each division. (For divisions with more than 20 participants, those placing 4th to 6th will be awarded a merit prize.)
- b. No awards will be presented for the Family Orienteering Experience event.
- c. Should any participants fail to attend or complete all scheduled matches, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify them from award eligibility.

13. LCSD Cup:

- This Competition is a scoring event of the **School Sports Programme Award Scheme (Pilot Scheme) – LCSD Cup**.
- A total of 16 awards will be presented. Trophies will be awarded at the 2026 School Sports Programme Prize Presentation Ceremony cum Carnival to honour schools with the most outstanding performance between 1 January 2026 and 10 June 2026. The awards include:

LCSD Cup – Primary School Boys’ Division: Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up and 3rd Runner-up

LCSD Cup – Primary School Girls’ Division: Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up and 3rd Runner-up

LCSD Cup – Secondary School Boys’ Division: Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up and 3rd Runner-up

LCSD Cup – Secondary School Girls’ Division: Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up and 3rd Runner-up
