Purpose : To provide a 20-session advanced squash training course of 40 hours for potential players.

Entry Requirement :

1. Applicants must be *aged 15 or below*;
2. Priority will be given to students who have participated in the Outreach Coaching Programme – Squash under the School Sports Programme and remain in the same school by the time of enrolment for this training programme;
3. Highest priority will be given to those who are aged 11 or over and have received the Bronze Award under the HKS Junior Squash Award Scheme.

Notes on Enrolment :

- Participants must, before the activity starts, pay attention to and comply with the latest epidemic prevention guidelines and requirements announcement by the Government and the Education Bureau.
- Participants must comply with the Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation (Cap. 599F), the mandatory mask-wearing requirement under the Prevention and Control of Disease (Wearing of Mask) Regulation (Cap. 599I), as well as the related guidelines and requirement of the LCSD's venues.

- Enrolment Method** : - The completed enrolment form should be returned by post together with a crossed cheque for payment of HK\$500 to the **School Sports Programme Unit, 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin**. Please specify “Joint Schools Squash Training Programme” on the envelope;
- The cheque should be made payable to “Hong Kong Squash”;
- Name of applicant and class reference number should be marked on the back of the cheque.
- Enrolment Deadline** : 24 February 2023 (Friday), as shown by the postmark
- Points to Note in Response to the Latest COVID-19 Situation** :
1. Participants should bring their own sports equipment, e.g. rackets and balls, as far as possible to reduce shared use of items.
 2. Participants should bring their own drinking water and personal hygiene products.
 3. Participants should maintain good personal hygiene and pay attention to their health condition. They should not attend the class if they have the most common symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, malaise, dry cough and shortness of breath. Other symptoms include nasal congestion, headache, conjunctivitis, sore throat, diarrhoea, loss of taste or smell, skin rash or discolouration of fingers or toes.
 4. Instructors/officials will immediately advise a participant to stop participating in the activity and seek medical attention as soon as possible if they find that his/her health condition is not suitable for participation in the class or he/she has the most common symptoms of COVID-19.
 5. Participants should wear a mask in accordance with the latest regulations of our venues.
