- 10 Remarks : (1) The list of successful participants and course notice will be published on the OAHK's website 8 days before the course commences. For enquiries, please contact the OAHK staff.
(2) Participants are advised to wear light-coloured, loose-fitting sportswear and sports shoes, and bring along water, a watch, a towel, a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, and rain gear. (Participants may bring a change of clothes for after class.)
(3) Participants should take care of their own clothing and personal belongings. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss. Please avoid bringing valuables to the class.
(4) If an **Amber, Red or Black Rainstorm Warning, or any tropical cyclone warning signal** is issued by the Hong Kong Observatory two hours before the class, the class will either be rescheduled or cancelled.
(5) If a **thunderstorm warning** is issued before the class or competition, participants are requested **to report to the meeting point**. The chief instructor will decide whether to continue the class based on the actual weather conditions at the time or adjust the arrangements according to weather changes.
(6) Once admitted, no refunds will be given. In case of insufficient participants, the Organiser may cancel or combine classes.
