Notice of Race



- 1. Objectives:** The Stanley Main Beach Spring Regatta is presented annually as a water sports centre event to promote the public's interest in sailing and windsurfing, boost up their skills and enhance the competition experiences.
- 2. Dates:** 9-10 May 2026 (Saturday and Sunday)
- 3. Time:** 9:00am to 5:00pm
- 4. Racing Area:** Stanley Main Beach Water Sports Centre (Tai Tam Bay)
- 5. Course:** Round Mark Course
- 6. Age:** Aged 14 or above (Participants' age is calculated against the commencement date of the race) ^(Note 1)
- 7. Fee:** HK\$20/person (Persons aged below 15, aged 60 or above, full-time students and persons with disabilities can enjoy concessionary rate upon production of valid proof)

Note 1: Applicants under 18 must submit a declaration of consent for participation in recreation and sports programmes before being allowed to enroll in competitions. Such a declaration must be made by their parents or guardians aged 18 or above who are themselves SmartPLAY users, with the use of the "Declaration" function under "My Profile" in SmartPLAY. The applicants may alternatively enter the passwords of their parents' or guardians' SmartPLAY accounts in submission of applications.

Note 2: For better resource utilization, the organiser reserves the right to adjust the quota for each division with reference to the enrolment response. If places are available after the First Phase of Open Enrolment, the organiser will flexibly adjust the final quotas for each division.

Note 3: Applicants should select respective required qualification in SmartPLAY, and choose / upload relevant required qualification document. They must produce the originals of valid qualification proof and logbooks for verification by the LCSD staff on the event day as proof that the relevant certificates or qualifications and the required number of sailing hours are acquired before ballot.

10. Notes on Enrolment:

- Applicants must submit ballot e-application forms through My SmartPLAY App, the SmartPLAY webpage or smart self-service stations within the specified period in a month.
- Applicants enrolling in competitions must be themselves the registered SmartPLAY users. Applications made by groups, organisations or schools will not be accepted.
- Each applicant/team may submit only one ballot application for enrolment in competitions organised by District Leisure Services Offices (DLSOs), Water Sports Centres or Tuen Mun Recreation and Sports Centre in a given month. In the event of duplicate application submissions, submission of incomplete information, non-compliance with competition requirements or ineligibility on the part of applicants/teams, the applications in question will be rejected by the system. Each ballot application form can be used to apply for up to 10 competitions, of which a maximum of three will be allocated to the applicant. Each applicant can only enrol ONE CLASS of the competition while the applicant is able to select in a maximum of 4 classes in same application form by priority for balloting.
- No waiting lists will be held for any ballot. Applicants are required to make a fresh application for the remaining places, if any, upon ballot on a first-come-first-served basis during the open enrolment period.
- As far as the application forms submitted are concerned, in the event of duplicate submissions, submission of incomplete information, non-compliance with competition requirements or ineligibility on the part of any of the participating members, the applications in question will be rejected by the system.

- (f) As far as the competitions held by the Water Sports Centres are concerned, applicants can enter a ballot only after valid certificates or qualification proof are uploaded in their submission of ballot e-application forms. In addition, they must produce the originals of valid qualification proof and logbooks for verification by the LCSD staff on the competition day as proof that the relevant certificates or qualifications and the required number of sailing hours are acquired before ballot. Failure to meet such requirements will disqualify the applicants from the competitions, and no refund for the fees paid will be made.
- (g) Alterations to all the details provided by an applicant will not be allowed after the submission deadline of application forms. The e-application forms must be completed in full and all the details therein must be true and correct. Alternations to all the details provided, participating event(s) and personal particulars will not be allowed once the applications have been confirmed, except for the circumstances of altering contact numbers and addresses, in which any updates must be made via SmartPLAY as soon as possible.
- (h) Applicants under 18 must submit a declaration of consent for participation in recreation and sports programmes before being allowed to enrol in competitions. Such a declaration must be made by their parents or guardians aged 18 or above who are themselves SmartPLAY users, with the use of the "Declaration" function under "My Profile" in SmartPLAY. The applicants may alternatively enter the passwords of their parents' or guardians' SmartPLAY accounts in submission of applications.
- (i) Applicants providing false information will be disqualified from the events, with all the results declared void. Enrolment fees paid will not be refunded.
- (j) If less than 2 applicants are enrolled in a division after the Phase I Open Enrolment for Remaining Quota (i.e. after 14 April 2026), that division will be cancelled.
- (k) Hong Kong residents should produce their Hong Kong Identity Cards (Birth Certificates / Documents of Identity for Visa Purposes also acceptable for children aged below 11). Children aged 14 or below may produce a copy of their identity documents. The original of a valid photograph-bearing student handbook / card should also be produced if their identity documents supplied do not bear a photograph. Persons without Hong Kong Identity Cards should produce their valid travel documents (such as Passports, Exit-Entry Permits for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao).
- (l) Unless under special circumstance, replacement of competitor will not be entertained after the deadline of submission. Participants cannot refund and change to another person after they have enrolled. Each competitor could only participate in one division. Competitors participate in more than one division will be disqualified.
- (m) Withdrawal or Release of Quota on or after 30 April 2026, 6 p.m. will not be opened for enrolment.
- (n) Water Sports Centre's "On-the-spot enrollment" is not applicable to this event.
- (o) The Organiser reserves the right to reject the use of any participant's entitlement to enrolment in competitions.

11. Rules: The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2025-2028 (RRS). Sailing Federation of Hong Kong, China Prescriptions, Notice of Race (NoR) and the Sailing Instructions (SIs) will also apply.

12. Ranking: Ranks of each race for respective divisions will be calculated according to the best finishing time.

13. Regulations:

1. A maximum of 5 races over 2 racing days. The scoring will be using "Low Point System" in accordance with RRS Appendix A4.
2. Subject to the wind velocity and the prevailing conditions, the race committee may continue, shorten or abandon the race. It will not be grounded for redress.
3. When 3 or fewer race(s) have been completed over 2 racing days, a competitor's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 4 or 5 races have been completed, a competitor's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14. Note to Competitors:

- 1. Reporting Time:** Competitors are required to Check-In via SmartPLAY by arriving the Centre between 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. on the race day, produce the **original** of the identity document used for enrolment and the **original** proof of relevant qualifications for verification.
- 2.** During the reporting time of the first day, the organiser will allocate the craft or/and sail numbers to the competitors by balloting.
- 3.** The organiser will upload the SIs to the website of the LCSD's water sports centres before the race. If any competitor has difficulty accessing the Sailing Instructions 3 days before the race, please contact the Centre staff at 2813 9117 during office hours.

- 16. Boat Arrangement:** The Centre reserves the right to request for compensation from the user if there is any damage to the Centre Boat/Board.
- 17. Race Cancellation:**
1. If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal or “extreme conditions” issued by the Hong Kong Observatory is in force at or after 7:00 a.m. on the race day, the races on that day shall be cancelled and shall not be rescheduled. If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1, the Amber/ Red Rainstorm Warning Signal, the Strong Monsoon Signal or the Thunderstorm Warning is issued at or after 7:00 am on the race day, competitors are required to report to the Centre. The organiser will decide whether the races should proceed as scheduled, adopt the alternative courses or be cancelled in the light of the prevailing weather conditions.
 2. In case of safety and public health issue, the LCSD reserves the right to cancel the races without prior notice to the competitors.
- 18. Race Result:** The results of each class will be posted on the notice board at the venue on the race day. The winners’ list will be uploaded to the LCSD WSCs website after the event (Path: Centre Activities > Races > Race Results)

- 19. Insurance:** Competitors should be insured on their own expenses.
- 20. Protest:** In addition to completing the protest procedure on the water, competitors are required to deliver their protest to the Protest Committee in writing within the official time limit after all races of the day have finished. The decision of the organiser shall be final. No appeal will be allowed against its decision.
- 21. Meal:** Competitors should bring their own food and drinks.
- 22. Requests for Certificates of Participation:** Requests for certificates of participation can be made by submitting to the Centre a completed application form together with a stamped addressed envelope (adequate postage).
