

Masters Games 2010/11 – Badminton Competition

~ Prospectus ~

1. Aim

Targeted at people aged 35 or above, the Masters Games emphasise participation and enjoyment rather than the winning of prizes. The Games also offer participants the opportunity to compete against people of similar ages to sustain their interest in sports activities.

2. Date & Time

: 10 – 31 October 2010 (Every Sat & Sun)

2:00 pm - 11:00 pm (Sat) 9:00 am - 11:00 pm (Sun)

3. Venue

Kwun Chung Sports Centre

(Address: 6/F, Kwun Chung Municipal Services Building, 17 Bowring Street, Jordon)

4. Eligibility

: People aged 35 or above are eligible to participate in the Games. Participants' age is calculated against the first day on which the event commences (i.e. those who were born on or before 10 October 1975 are eligible to participate in the competition).

- Points to Note: (1) Participants should be aware of their health condition, and consider whether it is suitable for them to enrol in this Games. In case of doubt, please consult a doctor prior to the enrolment of activity.
 - (2) Each participant may participate in a maximum of two events i.e. one singles event and one doubles event. He/She shall submit one enrolment form for each event only. The Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) reserves the right to disqualify any participant who has made repeated enrolments or has submitted an incomplete enrolment form.
 - (3) For participants entering the doubles event, the division they enter shall be the one to which their youngest team member belongs.
 - (4) If the number of participants/teams enrolled in any division is less than two, the LCSD reserves the right to combine it with a division of younger age or cancel all events in that division.
 - (5) In case only one participant/team turns up, he/she/the team will still be awarded the prize upon reporting at the venue.

6. Entry Fee

\$20/person

[Concessionary rates at half the normal charges are granted to persons aged 60 or above, full-time students and persons with disabilities and upon production of valid identification documents at the time of payment.]

7. Format

- (1) The single knock-out system will be adopted in all events.
- (2) For all events, the Rally Points Scoring System (a match consists of the best of 3 games of 21 points) will be applied.

8. Schedules & Rules

- Relevant supplementary information including schedules, notes to participants and (1) location map of the competition venue will be delivered to participants by post/fax/e-mail, or can be downloaded from the LCSD Masters Games webpage. If participants do not receive any information on the competition when the date of competition is drawing near, please contact the LCSD as soon as possible.
- (2) Participants shall arrive at the competition venue at the scheduled time and report to the staff of the LCSD.
- (3) Participants shall stay at the venue to prepare for the match after reporting. Those who turn up late to report/for competition for more than 5 minutes or dispatch not enough players in a doubles event will be regarded as having withdrawn from the match.
- (4) Participants shall produce their valid identification documents for verification of eligibility when they report to the staff of the LCSD and before the commencement of the match. The LCSD reserves the right to disqualify those who fail to produce valid identification documents.
- (5) Participants shall wear tidy sportswear and a pair of non-marking rubber-soled sports shoes.
- (6) Participants shall bring their own rackets while shuttlecocks will be provided by the LCSD.
- (7) Participants shall pay attention to the announcement made/notice displayed by the LCSD on the spot and comply with the rules and regulations of the venue.

- (8) If any participants fail to complete all matches, they will be disqualified and not given any award.
- (9) If any participants violate the regulations or display any misbehaviour which may affect the competition, the LCSD reserves the right to disqualify them from the competition.
- (10) If a participant withdraws from any match or is disqualified from taking part in the Games, the entry fee paid by him/her will not be refunded.
- (11) No appeal will be accepted. The decision of the umpire on the spot will be final.
- (12) The list of the winners for each division will be announced on the LCSD Masters Games webpage.
- (13) Unless explicitly stated in this prospectus, all rules and regulations will follow those currently adopted by the Hong Kong Badminton Association.
- 9. Umpire
- (1) Players on bye will take turns to serve as umpires in the preliminary rounds and they shall report on schedule for carrying out the umpire duties.
- (2) From the Round of 16 onwards, the umpire services will be arranged by the LCSD.
- 10. Awards

Medals will be awarded to the champion, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up and 3rd runner-up of each division.

- 13. Enrolment Methods
- (1) Completed enrolment forms should be submitted during the submission period (originals/copies of identification documents need not be attached or produced when the forms are submitted):

- c) Submission of enrolment forms via the Internet.
- (2) Each participant may participate in a maximum of two events, i.e. one singles event and one doubles event. He/She shall submit one enrolment form for each event only. The LCSD reserves the right to disqualify any participant who has made repeated enrolments or has submitted an incomplete enrolment form.
- (3) Participants will be selected by ballot.

- (4) The ballot will be held on 17 August 2010 at 3:00 pm at Audio-Visual Room, 1/F, Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin. Members of the public are welcome to attend.
- (5) The balloting results (only the Chinese and English names of participants will be disclosed) will be announced at the DLSOs of the LCSD, any recreational and sports venues with Leisure Link services and on the LCSD Masters Games webpage on 20 August 2010. Notification letters will be sent to successful applicants and applicants on the waiting list (no priority number will be assigned to applicants on the waiting list) while unsuccessful applicants will not be notified.
- (6) Successful applicants shall bring along their notification letters/identification documents (originals or copies) and entry fees to the DLSOs of the LCSD (during office hours) or any recreational and sports venues with Leisure Link services for verification of their personal particulars and payment of entry fees during the specified payment period. Successful applicants who fail to pay the required fees within the specified payment period will be regarded as waiving their rights. The unfilled places will be allocated to the applicants on the waiting list. Enrolment on a first-come-first-served basis will be accepted during the specified payment period for the applicants on the waiting list.

(7) If there are still unfilled places in individual divisions after the payment period for the applicants on the waiting list, or the number of submitted applications is less than the regular quota, the remaining quota will be open to the public for enrolment during the following period at <u>DLSOs</u> on a <u>first-come-first-served basis</u>.

- (8) For participants in doubles events, both players in a team shall pay the entry fees, or else the team will be regarded as waiving their rights of participation.
- 14. Remarks : If there is any inadequacy in this prospectus, the LCSD reserves the right for appropriate amendments.
- 15. Postponement : If Pre-No.8 special announcement, Tropical Cyclone Warning No.8 or above or a Black Rainstorm Signal is issued two hours before the first match scheduled to be held on the event day, all matches on that day will be cancelled and re-scheduled. Participants will be notified of the details in due course.
